CANCELLED TRIPS

MT Sobek reserves the right to cancel any trip due to inadequate enrollment or other cause that makes the trip unfeasible for us to operate but will inform you at least 45 days prior to departure. In such a case, a full travel credit toward a future trip or refund of Land/Cruise Cost is given, except in those instances such as epidemics where prepaid deposits or irrevocable commitments cannot be returned or reversed.
