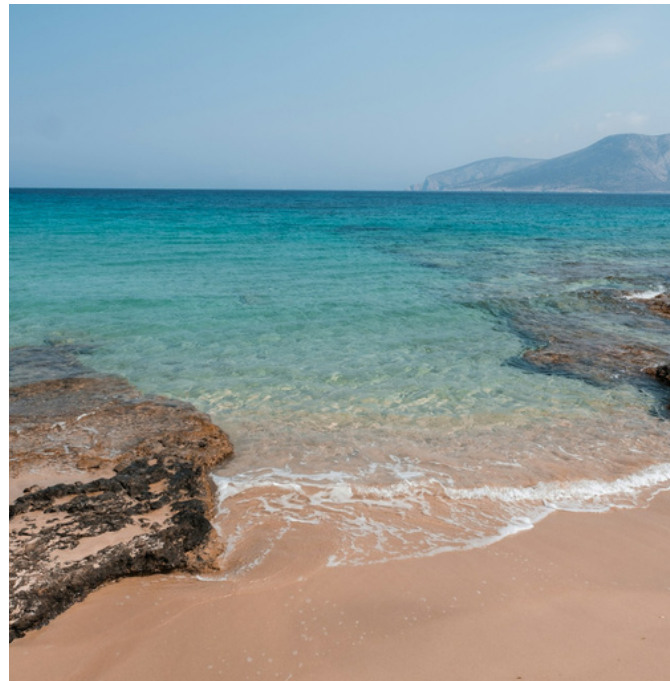

Arrive in Athens

Arrive at Athens airport and transfer to your hotel, perfectly located in the heart of the ancient city. Your guide will meet you in the evening for an orientation walk and welcome dinner in Plaka, Athens' historical neighborhood at the foot of the Acropolis.

Explore Ancient Athens - Ferry to Tinos

Explore Athens, once a powerful city-state and today the capital of Greece. Take the millennia-old journey up the hill to tour the Acropolis, the ancient citadel, and admire the Parthenon temple, dedicated to the goddess Athena. Marvel at the archeological treasures at the New Acropolis Museum, then tour the city on wheels to see the temple of Zeus, the Hellenic Parliament, and the Panathenaic Stadium that hosted the first Olympic Games. After a lunch in the port of Rafina, hop on a high-speed catamaran to Tinos, your first stop in the Cyclades.

Tinos Village to Village Hike

Today, hike and explore the enchanting island of Tinos. Starting from the village of Volax that sits nestled in a lunar landscape of large granite boulders, make your way to the tiny hillslope village of Koumaros. Refresh with a traditional Greek coffee that will power your climb to Xobougo hill with its splendid vistas over the Aegean Sea. Descend to the seaside village of Kionia and relax over a leisurely lunch and time to swim next to the remains of the ancient temple of Poseidon, the god of the sea. Enjoy the remainder of your day at leisure. Please note that today's hike is 5.5 miles with 820' of elevation gain.

Ferry to Mykonos - Olive Oil Tasting

Today after breakfast, say goodbye to Tinos as you board a ferry to your next stop in the Cyclades, stunning Mykonos! Upon arrival on Mykonos, set off for an olive oil tasting tour. Sample some of the finest olive oil in the world from its source. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure relaxing or exploring more of Mykonos on your own.

Private Tour of Delos Island

This morning after breakfast, take a scenic boat ride from Mykonos to the ancient and sacred island of Delos. Enjoy a walking tour through the ancient ruins and learn about the history of Greek mythology. This unique site has an extensive collection of archaeological discoveries including art, history, and architecture. The island is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is a sacred island of the ancient Greek world and is the birthplace of the gods Apollo and Artemis. After your tour of Delos, return to Mykonos where you'll enjoy lunch and the remainder of your day free to explore more of Mykonos, or enjoy time at the beach.

Ferry Ride to Naxos - Tour of Naxos Town

Conclude your day watching the spectacular sunset from Portara (the "big door") - Temple of Apollo.

Tour the Village of Naxos - Greek Cooking Class

Today set off to explore the villages of Naxos in the interior of the island and discover its unique tastes and traditions of the Naxian people. Enjoy a four-hour hands-on experience cooking class, where you'll cook a full traditional Naxian meal based on recipes handed down from generation to generation. Enjoy your evening at leisure, with an optional hike to Kouros statues (Kouros of Melanes and Kouros of Potamia) or free time to relax at the beach. The hike is approximately 4.3 miles.

Ferry to Santorini - Winery Tour and Tasting

After breakfast, catch a high-speed ferry to stunning Santorini, your final stop in the Cyclades. Santorini is an island created by a volcano eruption and one of the most photogenic places in all of Greece. Unwind with a winery visit and wine tasting tour. Santorini produces some of the best wine in Greece, with unique flavor profiles due to the volcanic soil. Enjoy the evening at leisure relaxing or exploring more of the area on your own.

Hike the Caldera Trail

Today, set off with a stunning hike from the town of Fira along the rim of Santorini's stunning caldera. Take in vistas of blue domes and whitewashed facades, a quintessential Santorini experience. Take in the magnificent sunset at Oia, one of the most famous sunsets in the world. The hike is approximately 6.6 miles, but can be shortened based on your ability and interests. Enjoy the evening exploring the town Oia on your own before heading back to your hotel for the evening.
