Full Day Private Guided Tour and Hike at the Grand Canyon

Drive to Sedona and Private Jeep Tour

After checking out of your hotel this morning, drive to Sedona.

This afternoon you will meet your private guide for a half day Jeep tour in Sedona's beautiful red rock country. You will ride in an open air Jeep past some of Sedona's most iconic red-rock formations to the Coconino National Forest. Continue on an original wagon route that once connected Sedona and Prescott. You will explore ancient cliff dwellings and pictographs and petroglyphs which offer a glimpse into the rich human history of the region. A picnic lunch will be served trailside.

Following your Jeep tour, check into your overnight accommodations.

Private Horseback Ride and Picnic Lunch and Private Stargazing

Today, head to a nearby ranch for a private horseback ride. Your private trail ride will be customized based on your personal experience and goals and no previous experience is necessary. You will stop for a picnic lunch in a scenic location allowing you to immerse in the serenity of this beautiful place.

Following your trail ride, you will have free time to relax and enjoy your accommodations. This evening meet an astronomer for a private stargazing experience. The Arizona desert's predictable weather, low humidity and dark night skies make it the perfect location for viewing the Milky Way Galaxy, millions of stars, recognizable constellations and even some far off galaxies millions of light years away. Your astronomer will choose the perfect location based on current conditions.

Sunrise Hot Air Balloon Flight and Private Guided Hike

Wake up early this morning for a sunrise hot air balloon flight over Sedona's red rock country, the Coconino National Forest, Boynton Canyon and Long Canyon. Experience spectacular views as the first pink rays of sun are bathing the desert in light. The early morning hours are when the winds are the calmest and wildlife is often spotted. Your flight lasts approximately one hour. After a peaceful landing enjoy a champagne and picnic breakfast.

Sedona has long been regarded as a place both sacred and powerful. The Sedona vortexes are thought to be swirling centers of energy that are conducive to healing, meditation and self-exploration. These are places where the earth seems especially alive with energy. Many people feel inspired, recharged or uplifted after visiting a vortex. Today you will meet your private guide and visit two amazing high energy areas for a relaxing walking tour. The first offers a sacred Tibetan place of prayer. While there, your guide will provide energy healing through Reiki on the Rocks. Reiki is a wonderful form of relaxation, healing, and stress reduction. The second energy stop will be an area high atop a knoll with the very best views of the Red Rock Wilderness. Here your guide will teach simple meditation techniques that you can easily practice at home. Your tour will be approximately three hours. Return to your accommodation in the late morning and you will have the rest of the day free to relax and enjoy the pool and spa.
