New England Leaf-Peeping Custom Adventure

On this 9-day custom custom adventure see the highlights of New England and catch the leaves' brilliant colors traveling through Maine, Vermont, and New Hampshire. As the crisp fall air descends upon the region, the landscape transforms into a breathtaking tapestry of vibrant hues, ranging from fiery reds and oranges to rich yellows. Travelers embark on scenic drives, meandering through picturesque small towns and rural landscapes, stopping at parks along the way for short hikes and panoramic overlooks, and for outdoor adventure such as horseback rides and organic farm visits.

This trip was designed with a focus on culture and leaf-peeping in September or October, but can be adjusted for routes or activities if visiting during other times of the year. The journey is completely customizable based on interests.

Arrive Boston and Afternoon History Tour

Upon arrival in Boston, Massachusetts, collect your rental car and head to your overnight accommodations in downtown Boston. Valet parking is included in your stay.

This afternoon, meet your guide to visit all 16 of Boston's Freedom Trail sites. Learn about icons like Paul Revere and John Hancock, along with lesser-known stories of women, African Americans, and immigrant patriots and pioneers. You will leave with an understanding of Boston's role in the American Revolution but also how Boston has pioneered abolition, American education, and immigration. It all happened at these famous sites along the iconic red brick line. After your tour, the rest of the day is yours, free to explore on your own. We recommend visiting nearby neighborhoods such as Beacon Hill and the North End, or journeying to nearby Cambridge, the home of Harvard and MIT.

Drive to Bar Harbor, Maine and Portland City Tour

After bidding farewell to your hotel, embark on a drive north towards Bar Harbor, Maine. Make the most of your road trip by stopping to explore some of Maine's local character. If time allows, first check out renowned seaside town of Kennebunkport for a taste of its coastal charm.

This afternoon, explore the vibrant city of Portland through a comprehensive city tour. See the lively downtown area with its diverse array of shops and businesses, wander through the Arts District and the historic Old Port with its top-notch restaurants and bars, and admire the brownstones and Victorian architecture of residential neighborhoods. Witness lobstermen hard at work along the waterfront, revel in the stunning ocean vistas providing sweeping views of Casco Bay, its islands, and forts. Don't miss the opportunity to visit Portland Head Light, the most iconic lighthouse in the nation, and absorb intriguing stories and historical facts that have shaped Portland into one of the most historic cities in the nation.

After your tour, continue onward to Bar Harbor.

Full Day Private Tour of Acadia National Park

This morning, meet your private guide and driver for a full day guided tour of Acadia National Park and Desert Island. The tour is customizable to your interests and energy levels on the day and may include sites like Sand Beach, Thunder Hole, Otter Cliff, Otter Cove, Jordan Pond, and Cadillac Mountain. Enjoy easy walks throughout the tour as your interests dictate. After the tour, return to Bar Harbor and enjoy the remainder of the day on your own.

Bar Harbor Culinary Tour and Scenic Drive to New Hampshire

Leaving your hotel, meet your private guide for a captivating Bar Harbor culinary discovery walking tour. Throughout the tour sample local specialties while gaining fascinating insights into the history of the town and its surroundings. Wander from one culinary gem to the next, covering less than a mile on foot but savoring a wealth of culinary experiences. (During Spring and Summer months, optional whale-watching cruises or private catamaran cruises, including clam-bakes, are also possible). After your tour, set out on a picturesque drive to your overnight accommodations in the charming New Hampshire town of North Conway.

New Hampshire Parks Self-Explore and Private Vermont Horseback Ride

Today after checking out of your hotel, drive west toward Burlington, Vermont. You'll first travel along the scenic Kancamagus Highway 112 through beautiful White Mountain National Forest, famous for its fall foliage. The 34-mile stretch in New Hampshire between Conway and Lincoln is full of outdoor activity options which you can stop at and explore on your own, such as Rocky Gorge, Lower Falls, or Lost River Gorge.

As you pass into Vermont, the classic charming New England town of Stowe, is worthy of a stroll. This afternoon, stop at the beautiful Franconia Stables for a private one-hour guided horseback ride through fields and forests, leading to beautiful mountain views. Keep an eye open for moose, deer, wild turkeys, and beavers as you pass along mountain streams. (During Spring and Summer months, optional kayaking or canoe tours are also available.)

Burlington, Vermont Explorations

Today you have a choice of various activities, all of which are great ways to explore Burlington. You may wish to explore Lake Champlaign on a guided eBike tour or a scenic cruise. You could also tour famous local institutions such as Ben & Jerry's on their factory tour or visit the iconic Shelbourne Farms & Museum. Or perhaps you'd like to sample the craft brewery scene on a guided tasting tour through downtown Burlington. Multiple activities are possible on this day

Vermont Route 100 Scenic Drive, State Parks Self-Explore, and Organic Farm Tour

Today you'll drive south on scenic Vermont Route 100, first to Vergennes Falls State Park and Quechee State Park, then onward to the towns of Warren and Woodstock, with the option of stopping to explore any of these Vermont points of interest.

Along the way you'll also stop to meet your guide for a delectable private organic farm and food tour around the rolling hills of Vermont. Pop a sweet cherry tomato in your mouth and pick some blueberries or put your hands in the warm soil and plant something. During the tour, you'll harvest some veggies for your lunch-time homemade salad and learn about sustainable gardening and farming methods before enjoying an outdoor picnic with fresh-picked ingredients.
