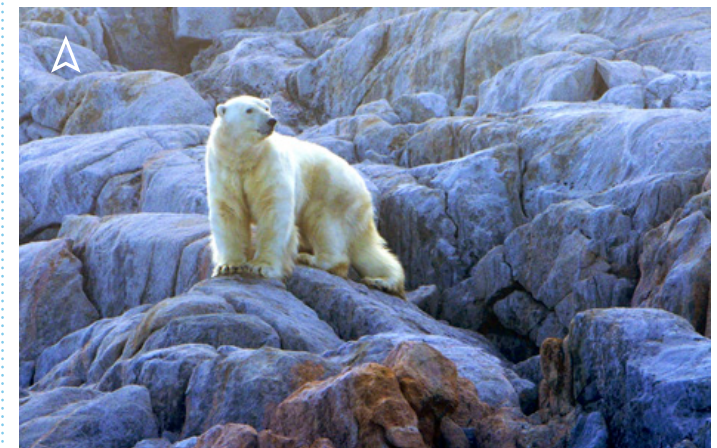

We will provide you with rendezvous instructions and final trip details approximately three weeks prior to trip departure.

WHAT YOUR TRIP INCLUDES

The Land and/or Cruise Cost* for most trips includes: Expert leadership, accommodations as noted in the itinerary, field arrangements (including camp and cook staff, group camping and commissary equipment, necessary activity equipment), all or most meals, sightseeing as noted in the trip itinerary, group airport transfers, ground transportation and support vehicles, local guides and support staff/porters, entrance fees and permits.

Per TripMate's policy, the Optional Travel Protection Plan is not available for guests with an international address (non-US address), and per TripMate's policy, the Optional Travel Protection Plan is not available for guests traveling to Iran, Syria, North Korea, Crimea, Iraq, Palestinian Authority, Sudan and Cuba effective immediately.

TRANSFERS

Requests to transfer from one trip to another within 94 days of departure are subject to the Cancellation Fees outlined above (appropriate to the date you notify us of your wish to transfer). No transfers are allowed on Cruises, Custom, Private and Special Departures.

CANCELLED TRIPS

MT Sobek reserves the right to cancel any trip due to inadequate enrollment or other cause that makes the trip unfeasible for us to operate, but will inform you at least 45 days prior to departure. In such a case, a full travel credit toward a future trip or refund of Land/Cruise Cost is given, except in those instances such as epidemics where prepaid deposits or irrevocable commitments cannot be returned or reversed. In any event, MT Sobek will provide alternative travel dates for a postponed trip. If a refund is sought, only recoverable funds will be provided. MT Sobek is not responsible for additional expenses incurred by members preparing for the trip (e.g. non-refundable Advance Purchase air tickets, visa fees if applicable, clothing, equipment, or medical expenses). Do not purchase your air tickets before speaking with your Adventure Coordinator.

If a trip is cancelled or postponed due to force majeure (war, labor strikes, earthquakes, flooding, epidemic, a major world event adversely affecting international travel patterns, etc.), MT Sobek will provide a travel credit or refund the portion of the trip cost that is recoverable after using good faith efforts to recover payments already advanced to suppliers (hotels, transportation companies, etc.) We will refund the balance as promptly as possible. However, MT Sobek does not guarantee recovery of any or all of the advance payments made, and our use of good faith efforts to recover these payments will not include the institution of any legal proceedings. MT Sobek is not responsible for expenses incurred by trip members in preparing for a cancelled or postponed trip (e.g., non-refundable purchase of air tickets, visa fees, inoculations, equipment, etc.) or for any additional arrangements should the trip member depart prior to the scheduled group departure date.

BAGGAGE

MT Sobek assumes no liability for loss or damage to baggage in transit to and from a MT Sobek trip or while on a MT Sobek trip. We recommend purchasing the optional travel protection plan.

DELAYS & COST INCREASES

The cost of delays is not included if any trip is delayed due to bad weather, trail conditions, river levels, road conditions,

transportation delays, government intervention, quarantine, sickness, border closures or other contingency for which MT Sobek or its third party operators cannot make provisions. Land/Cruise Costs are subject to increase without prior notice, even after you have signed up on the trip.

We often publish our prices more than a year in advance. Between that time and the time of the trip's actual departure, we are occasionally faced with significant cost increases that we cannot absorb (i.e. foreign currency fluctuations, fuel surcharges, or increases in cost of services). We regret this situation, and we do everything we can to avoid raising prices, but sometimes it is unavoidable. We will do our best to limit such increases and will notify you before final payment. We will not, however, increase the price after your final payment.

AIRLINES

The airlines are not to be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not on board their planes or conveyance. The passage contract in use by the airlines concerned, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the airlines and such purchasers of these tours and/or passenger. Such conveyance, etc. is subject to the laws of the countries involved. Please read the conditions on the back of your airline ticket.

Airlines used vary in degree of safety and risk. Some foreign air carriers have an unknown safety and maintenance record. MT Sobek is not liable for incidents involving airline safety, risk, delays, etc., or incidents that result in injury, delay, or death.

MEDICAL & HEALTH

It is vital that persons with medical problems make them known to us well before departure. The trip leader has the right to disqualify anyone at any time during the trip if he or she feels the trip member is physically or mentally incapable or if a trip member's continued participation will jeopardize the individual involved or the group. Refunds are not given under such circumstances. Hospital facilities are often unavailable and evacuation can be prolonged, difficult, and expensive. MT Sobek assumes no liability regarding provision of medical care. You will need to provide us with your medical history and any dietary restrictions as requested in the required documentation.

If you participate on certain designated trips including those with the Activity Level of "Level 5", the Physician Certificate must be signed by your physician. Once you have been confirmed on a trip, normal cancellation fees apply if your doctor does not approve the Physician Certificate. We can send you this form prior to you making your reservation so your doctor can pre-approve you. The State Department (www.travel.state.gov) and the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (www.cdc.gov) periodically issue statements, advisories, and warnings about risks to travelers. These statements are country specific and contain important information. We strongly urge all participants to review any State Department warnings, alerts, advisories, and destination specific information at www.travel.state.gov as well as specific health information for their destination at www.cdc.gov.

PHOTOGRAPHY

MT Sobek may take photographs and/or video of its trips and trip participants grant MT Sobek permission to do so and for it to use same for promotional or commercial use without payment of any compensation to participant.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF TRIP MEMBERS

Trip members have certain responsibilities to MT Sobek and to other trip members. Trip members are responsible for understanding the conditions stated in the Trip Itinerary and selecting a trip in consultation with MT Sobek that is appropriate to their interests and abilities and for preparing for the trip by studying the Trip Itinerary, vaccination requirements, and supplemental trip information sent by MT Sobek. Screening for fitness (for trips rated "Level 4" or "Level 5") is made by our Regional Specialists at the time of booking. At the trip leader's discretion, a member may be asked to leave the trip at their own expense and without right of refund if the leader feels that the person's further participation may be detrimental to the individual or to other trip members for any reason including illness, physical inability to participate at trip level, disruptive behavior, etc. Please see MT Sobek's Code of Conduct.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Except for certain equipment in Alaska, Utah, Idaho, Portugal and Patagonia, as well as certain personnel employed on trips operated in the United States, Mountain Travel, Mountain Travel Sobek, MT Sobek, Alaska Discovery, Inc., its and their owners, directors, officers, employees and affiliates, (collectively Mountain Travel) does not own or operate any entity which is to or does provide goods or services for your trip including, for example, ownership or control over hotels or other lodging facilities, airline, vessel, bus, van or other transportation companies, local ground operators, providers or organizers of optional or included excursions or equipment used thereon, food service or entertainment providers, etc. All such persons and entities are independent contractors. As a result, Mountain Travel is not liable for any negligent or willful act or failure to act of any such person or entity, or of any other third party. Participants assign all right, title, and interest they may have in or to any and all media in which my name or likeness might be used by Mountain Travel. Participants agree to follow all written and verbal rules of safety presented to them by Mountain Travel and the independent contractors it employs. Mountain Travel reserves the right to refuse as a trip participant, or remove from a trip, without refund, any person it judges to be incapable of meeting the rigors and requirements of participating in the activities, or who is abusive or disrespectful to other trip participants, guides or third parties, or who it determines to detract from the enjoyment of the trip by others Mountain Travel reserves the right to change hotels or other features of the trips itinerary if Mountain Travel believes it will enhance the safety, comfort or enjoyment of the trip.

(JAMS). Such proceedings will be governed by substantive (but not procedural) California law without consideration of the California Arbitration Act and will take place in San Francisco, CA. The arbitrator and not any federal, state, or local court or agency shall have exclusive authority to resolve any dispute relating to the interpretation, applicability, enforceability, conscionability, or formation of this contract, including but not limited to any claim that all or any part of this contract is void or voidable. Please understand that by agreeing to these terms and conditions, you (and we) are waiving our right to a trial by jury. Any arbitration commenced against Mountain Travel must be on behalf of only the signatory to this Agreement and his or her immediate family members who traveled with the signatory, such as a spouse or child. 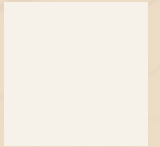
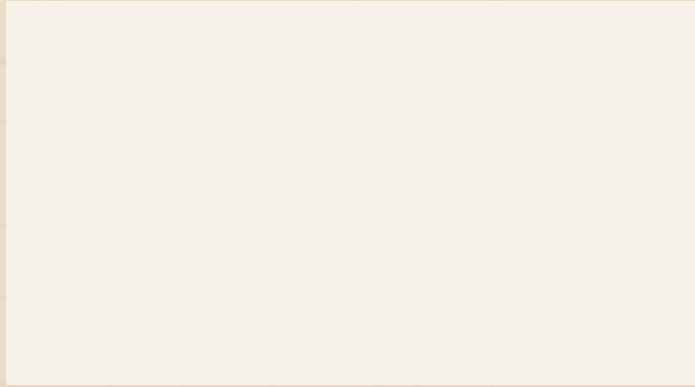
