Itinerary

DAY 1 ARRIVE IN ALGIERS

Welcome to Algeria! Arrive in Algiers and transfer to your five-star hotel, located close to the vibrant city center. Enjoy a welcome dinner at the hotel.

Meals: D

DAY 2 VISIT DJEMILA, THE ANCIENT ROMAN CITY OF CUICUL

Drive to the small mountain village of Djemila, originally the Roman city of Cuicul, and explore some of the best-preserved Roman ruins in North Africa. Originally dating back to the 1st century, these UNESCO-listed ruins include well-preserved baths, temples, and forums, and the impressive Arch of Caracalla — all spread out over a pretty meadow. After the tour, enjoy lunch in Djemila before heading to the atmospheric city of Constantine, where your next hotel awaits.

DAY 3 VISIT TIDDIS & CONSTANTINE

Set out this morning to explore the Roman city of Tiddis, perched on a bare, red-rock mountainside. Then return to Constantine to see the city's spectacular sights on a guided walking tour. Marvel at its cliff-side location and impressive bridges, including the Sidi M'Cid suspension bridge with its dizzying span over the gorge. Learn more about the city's history with a visit to the Cirta Museum, the Ottoman-era Bey's Palace, and El Kantara - the old Roman bridge. Learn more about the people of Constantine by meeting local copper and brassware makers, and visiting a WWI memorial dedicated to Constantine soldiers. Finish the tour at the Emir Abdelkader Mosque, an architectural gem.

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DAY 4 VISIT TIMGAD & THE BERBER VILLAGE OF RHOUFFI

Begin your day at the massive cone-shaped mausoleum of Medracen, built for the Berber Numidian Kings between 200-400 BC. Then explore the UNESCO-listed Roman military colony of Timgad, built during the reign of Emperor Trajan. This 2,000-year-old city has a remarkable grid design and its triumphal Arch of Trajan soars elegantly above Timgad. Next visit the Roman ruins of Lambaesis, a short drive west near the village of Tazoult, and explore the museum. From here, journey to Biskra through one of the most beautiful regions of the country. Marvel at the Berber village of Arris, with its stone houses clinging to the cliff side, and nearby gorges of Tighanimine. Follow the canyon towards Rhouffi and M 'Chounech, and stop to visit of the pottery workshop

and the museum of Si El Haouès. Continue to Sidi Okba, a historical and religious city and visit the mosque with its beautiful carved cedar door. Arrive in Biskra, gateway to the Sahara, and enjoy dinner.

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DAY 5 VISIT THE GARDENS OF BISKRA & JOURNEY TO EL OUED

Wander among palm trees at Biskra's beautiful Landon Garden this morning, then enjoy the sights and smells of the date market. From Biskra the journey continues to El Oued, through the date-rich Souf region. Overnight in El Oued tonight.

DAY 6 EXPLORE EL OUED, CITY OF A THOUSAND DOMES

Rise to visit of the minaret of the Sidi Salem mosque, the spice market, and the Zaouia des Tidjania, a local religious community. After lunch, take a 1-hour 4x4 excursion through the Grand Erg Oriental dunes. Enjoy sunset on the dunes before returning for dinner and overnight in El Oued.

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DAY 7 DISCOVER OASES IN THE GREAT EASTERN ERG & GHARDAIA

Head to Touggourt through the Grand Erg Oriental, a wondrous sea of sand also known as the Great Eastern Erg. Along the way, stop off at the salt lakes of Témacine and Tamelhat, and explore the fortified villages and palm groves of Ouargla. Enjoy lunch after a visit to the Saharan museum, and then continue to Ghardaia in the heart of the M'Zab Valley. Experience the unique auction market in Béni Isguen, the holy city of Ghardaia, and transfer to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Ghardaia.

DAY 8 MARVEL AT THE PENTAPOLIS OF M'ZAB

Explore the incredible UNESCO-listed towns of the M'Zab Valley in the northern Sahara. Known as the Pentapolis of M'Zab, the five fortified towns are a wonder to behold — rising enigmatically from the dunes in terraces centered around a central mosque. On your journey, you'll visit Ghardaia, Melika, age-old El Atteuf, and the holy city of Beni Isguen. Return to your residence in the late afternoon and enjoy a quiet stroll in the palm grove before dinner.

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DAY 9 EXPLORE HISTORIC ALGIERS

Take an early flight back to Algiers and go deep into the heart of the city on a guided tour, starting at the UNESCO-listed casbah. Explore the labyrinthine alleys of this storied hillside citadel and the historic quarter clustered around it. Visit its illuminating museums and ancient mosques, including the Bardo Museum and 15th-century Ketchaoua Mosque, and see the 18th-century Dar Hassan Pacha palace. Lunch at a traditional house in the casbah before continuing your tour, meeting local artisans along the way. You'll also have an opportunity to explore the Basilica "Notre Dame d'Afrique" and the stunning Test Garden of Hamma — a 94-acre botanical garden dating from 1832. Transfer to the airport and have dinner at the airport Hyatt Regency before flying on to Djanet late this evening.

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DAY 10 FLY TO DJANET AND SEE AGE-OLD DESERT ROCK ART

After breakfast, enjoy a fascinating visit to the oasis of Djanet and explore early rock paintings in "the cave of the ambassadors." After lunch, departure by caravan of 4x4 vehicles to Djaren, journey on to Djaren — the "Gateway to the Tadrart Rouge." Navigate rolling dunes to the first cave paintings hidden among the rocks, including a beautiful depiction of giraffes. Enjoy "Tuareg" tea along the way and first in the desert.

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DAY 11 TRAVEL TO MOUL ENNAGA DESERT CAMP

After breakfast, continue to Moul Ennaga, marked by gigantic rock spires and a spectacular network of dunes. Sip a refreshing cup of tea before heading to your desert camp. Dinner and overnight under the stars in Moul Ennaga.

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DAY 12 JOURNEY TO BOUHEDIANE & TIN MERZO

Travel through dunes and ocher-colored canyons on today's journey to Tin Merzouga. Along the way, explore the interesting engravings and paintings at Bouhediane. Stop for a picnic lunch and tea before reaching the colossal

red sand dunes of Tin Merzouga — among the highest in the Sahara! Watch the sunset over the magnificent landscape including Libya's Akakus Massif. Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay at the camp in Tin Merzouga.

Activity: 2 hours walking to visit rock sites

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DAY 13 DISCOVER ENGRAVINGS AT TESSAKETA

Awake in the desert, then journey across the sand and through rock-strewn gorges to find more rock paintings and engravings, including those at Tessaketa in Djaren. Stop for tea on the way. Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay at the camp in Tessaketa.

Activity: 2 hours walking to visit rock sites

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DAY 14 EXPLORE THE ERG OF ADMER & RETURN TO DIANET

Begin the day with a drive to Tagharghart in the Erg of Admer. Amidst this vast ocean of sand dunes and wind-sculpted rocks, you'll find 10,000-year-old rock engravings — including the famous "crying cow." Marvel at the skillfully engraved ancient art before a picnic lunch and Tuareg tea at the foot of the rocks. Contemplate sunset over the dunes and return to Djanet for dinner at the hotel.

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DAY 15 TOUR DJANET & RETURN TO ALGIERS

Start the morning with a tour of Tassili N'Ajjer Park Museum, housing 15,000 rupestral rocks dating from 6,000 to 12,000 years ago! Then explore Djanet's oasis and market, where Tuareg artisans sell locally crafted wares. Bid farewell to the desert after lunch and transfer to the airport for your return flight to Algiers. Settle into your luxury hotel and enjoy dinner at your leisure, on your own.

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DAY 16 ANCIENT WONDERS OF TIPASA & CHERCHELL

Head to Tipasa for an unforgettable look at its UNESCO-listed complex of ruins, including a beautifully situated ancient Roman city — one of Algeria's most impressive archeological sites. Explore the amphitheater, basilicas,

and forums while taking in dazzling views of the Mediterranean. Then visit the monumental Royal Mausoleum
