ACTIVITIES

Moderate to strenuous hiking on rocky paths, covering 6 to 10 miles per day at elevations ranging from 4,000 to 9,500 feet.

LODGING

Comfortable three-star, lodgestyle accommodation in a fivestar alpine setting. Includes the historic Ahwahnee Hotel.

CLIMATE

Expect sunny days in July, August, and September with temps in the 70s to 90s; morning and nighttime temps can drop into the 40s. Be prepared for rain showers.







KNOW BEFORE YOU BOOK

Accommodation

The national park accommodations on this trip provide great access to the top activities in the area. However, they are simpler compared to what we usually consider comfortable lodging - the rooms being more basic. Some buildings date back to the early 1900s and have been minimally renovated to follow park regulations. Overall, the service might feel slower and meal quality and selection much more limited compared to other MT Sobek trips. Keep in mind that internet and cell phone service are very limited throughout the parks.

The Itinerary



Hike Mariposa Grove & Transfer to Yosemite Valley

Welcome to Fresno, California. An MT Sobek representative will pick you up this morning from your pretrip hotel. After an orientation meeting at a local park, transfer to Mariposa Grove for a stunning hike among a grove of more than 500 giant sequoias tree. Marvel at the most famous trees, including the 3,000-year-old Grizzly Giant. After a picnic lunch, continue to Yosemite Valley with a stop at Tunnel View. Settle into your home for the next 2 nights and meet for dinner.

MEALS: Lunch Dinner TRANSPORTATION: 1.5-hour private van transfer ACTIVITY: 1.5-2 hours/3 miles hiking with 50' elevation gain and loss



Explore Yosemite Valley

Embark on a rewarding, mostly flat hike on the valley floor today, through lesser-traveled meadows, forests, and paths along the Merced River, past icons such as El Capitan, Sentinel Rock, Three Brothers, and Bridalveil Falls. Break for a trailside lunch along the way. There will be an opportunity to swim in the Merced River during an afternoon break. Return to the lodge in the late afternoon.

MEALS: Breakfast |Lunch |Dinner **ACTIVITY:** 4-6 hours/8 miles hiking with 100' gain and loss



Walk Among Yosemite's Waterfalls & Giant Sequoias

Check out early and climb 2,000 feet alongside Vernal Falls to admire the vista from the top of neighboring Nevada Falls. Return to Yosemite Valley in the early afternoon, then travel to your lodge, situated on the northern boundary of the park. En route, enjoy a late afternoon walk to gaze up at giant sequoias, among the oldest and largest living organisms on the planet! Check in to your room this evening and enjoy dinner at the lodge.

MEALS: Breakfast |Lunch | DinnerTRANSPORTATION: 1.5-hour private van transferACTIVITY: 7-8 hours/5.4 miles hiking with 2,000' elevation gain/loss; 3 miles with 520' gain/loss





Hike to Yosemite Valley's North Rim

Spend the day in Yosemite's high country. Begin your hike at 8,800 feet and enjoy a gradual descent through ponderosa pines, meadows, and along granite bluffs to marvel at the park's only intact arch. After a trailside lunch, hike to the top of North Dome (7,543') on the North Rim of Yosemite Valley and delight in the eye-popping views of its most famous landmark, Half Dome, along with the valley floor 3,500 feet below. Return to the lodge in the late afternoon.

MEALS: Breakfast Lunch Dinner TRANSPORTATION: 1.5-hour private van transfer ACTIVITY: 4-6 hours / 9.5 miles hiking with 1,000' gain and loss



Hike Trails from Tuolumne Meadows

Admire the beauty of Tuolumne Meadows (8,600'), one of the highest meadows in the Sierra Nevada range, on a day hike among its famous granite domes. Depending on conditions, the group will either follow an out-and-back trail to Cathedral Lakes (8 miles) or Mono Pass (7.4 miles). Both routes offer breathtaking mountain and meadow views, and are among the best hikes in the park. Return to your hillside lodge this evening.

MEALS: Breakfast |Lunch | Dinner TRANSPORTATION: Two 2.5-hour private van transfers ACTIVITY: 6-7 hours/7-9 miles hiking with 800'-900' elevation gain



Return to Fresno & Depart

Following breakfast at the hotel, take a 2.5-hour transfer to the airport and depart.

The Ahwahnee Hotel

The historic Ahwahnee Hotel (formerly known as the Majestic Yosemite Hotel) is located in the heart of the stunning Yosemite Valley. Constructed from steel, stone, concrete, wood and glass, the hotel was specifically designed to highlight its natural surroundings — featuring Yosemite Falls, Half Dome and Glacier Point. The Ahwahnee is a premier example of National Park architecture, and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, and is a National Historic Landmark. The accommodations are comfortably appointed while still providing an authentic National Park Lodge experience.

Rush Creek Lodge

Rush Creek Lodge is a superbly designed property located at the West Entrance of Yosemite National Park. The decor is inspired by the breathtaking expanse of nature surrounding its 20-acre wooded hillside setting. All rooms have been thoughtfully designed and tastefully appointed with modern amenities like comfy beds, feather pillows, gourmet coffee brewers, games, and books. Relax after the day's adventures in the outdoor pool and hot tubs or cozy up around the fire pit for stargazing and s'mores.
