The trip concludes having roamed through some of the most dramatic scenery the Rocky Mountains have to offer.

## Itinerary

#### DAY 1 MAKE YOUR WAY TO THE LEGENDARY TOWN OF BANFF

Arrive in Banff, Alberta, Canada (from Calgary) any time today. There are several daily shuttles from the closest airport in Calgary to Banff (approximately a 2-hour drive) where tonight's hotel stay is included.

#### DAY 2 TRAVEL TO LAKE LOUISE AND HIKE TO LAKE ANNETTE

Meet our guides at the hotel restaurant this morning. We'll enjoy breakfast and a brief orientation before heading out for drive along one of the world's most scenic mountain roads, to the heart of Canada's hiking capital! We then head to our home for the next 4 nights to prepare lunch before heading out on the trail. Our hike today takes us underneath a some mountain giants of the Canadian Rockies at Lake Annette.. Enjoy the views of the 3rd highest peak in Banff National Park while getting to know your fellow travelers. As we return to the campground our guides will prepare some delicious post hike snacks while you get yourself set up in your tent.

Activity: 6.8 miles hiking with 1210' elevation gain and loss

Meals: B, L, D

#### DAY 3 HEAD TO JASPER; HIKE TO ATHABASCA GLACIER AND PARKER RIDGE OR WILCOX PASS

We hike in Jasper National Park today. The first stop is to view Peyto Lake from a platform hanging on a cliff high above. Depending upon the time of year, the hue of the lake runs from dark blue to opaque turquoise to gorgeous jade green. The road then takes us onto the Columbia Icefield, the geo-hydrographic center of North America. Meltwaters from the Icefield and its glacial tongues feed 3 different oceans. We walk up to the toe of the Athabasca Glacier. Everything you've ever wanted to know about glaciers - this is the place to learn! Then we continue hiking up to either Parker Ridge for a spectacular view of the Saskatchewan Glacier from above or, for a true wilderness experience, a hike up to Wilcox Pass. Returning to camp, we'll enjoy dinner around the campfire. All meals included.

Activity: 5 miles hiking with 1,000'-1,200' elevation gain and loss

Meals: B, L, D

#### DAY 4 HIKE TO A TEAHOUSE ABOVE LAKE LOUISE; RAFT THE KICKING HORSE RIVER

We spend the morning hiking to the charming Lake Agnes Tea House. The trail to the tea house begins in an old-growth spruce forest before popping out to open views of glacier-fed Lake Louise. Once at the tea house we enjoy the vistas with the option to refuel on over 100 varieties of loose leaf tea and freshly baked goods. In the afternoon a bus ride takes us through Yoho National Park into British Columbia for rock-and-roll rafting on the

Kicking Horse River. This exhilarating trip allows us to raft the best section of the class III-IV whitewater rapids. We return to camp for dinner. All meals included.

Activity: 7 miles hiking with 1,300' elevation gain and loss; 3 hours rafting

# DAY 5 ENJOY STUNNING VIEWS OF WORLD-FAMOUS MORAINE LAKE AND HIKE THROUGH THE HIGH ALPINE PARADISE OF LARCH VALLEY

At turquoise Moraine Lake, we take in the famed view of the Valley of Ten Peaks (each peak over 10,000'). From here, we hike through Larch Valley, its meadowlands filled with dense stands of alpine larch and panoramic views over the Valley of the Ten Peaks. Continuing to lovely Eiffel Lake, the towering Rocky Mountains surround us. Time and weather permitting, we may hike the Helen Lake trail, famous for its summer wildflowers. Our last celebratory dinner will be at a restaurant in Lake Louise. All meals included.

Activity: 7-11 miles hiking with 1,300'-1,800' elevation gain and loss

Meals: B, L, D

#### DAY 6 HIKE TO THE FOOT OF STANLEY GLACIER

After breaking camp and waving goodbye to our campground, we head south into Kootenay National Park for a hike to Stanley Glacier. Considered one of the park's most spectacular trails, our hike to the base of Stanley Glacier rewards us with a diverse range of terrain. With an endless supply of geological treasures such as hanging valleys, ice caves, sheer cliffs, and towering peaks our final miles together will be the perfect culmination of an amazing exploration of the Canadian Rockies. These stunning views are a worthy finish to a great week of hiking! Our trip concludes in Banff with a drop off at the hotel where we spent night one. Breakfast and lunch included.

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Activity: 5 miles hiking with 1,200' elevation gain and loss
