The Itinerary

DAY 01

Arrive in Quito

Welcome to the historic city of Quito, the capital of Ecuador. An MT Sobek representative will meet you outside customs at the airport and escort you to your hotel. After settling in at the hotel, the rest of the evening is free to unwind and take advantage of the pool and onsite restaurant. Dinner is on your own tonight.

TRANSPORTATION: 1 hour private van transfer

DAY 02

Tour Mindo & Learn How Chocolate is Made

After breakfast, depart for a full-day tour to Mindo, a village in the Andean Mountains that's known for its many bird and butterfly species. Visit a cacao farm and factory and learn how chocolate is made, from harvesting the plants to the final product. Enjoy a welcome lunch surrounded by an incredible diversity of hummingbirds. Return to Quito in the afternoon for an introductory talk and orientation about your trip. In the evening, explore Quito and have dinner on your own.

DAY 03

Journey to the Amazon

After breakfast, transfer to Quito airport for a short flight to Coca airport, located on the Amazon side of the Andes. From there, take a two-hour motorized boat ride along the Napo River, then transfer by canoe to your lakeside lodge, looking for monkeys, sloths, and other wildlife. Settle into comfortable jungle-view rooms, your home for the next few days.

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 1-hour van transfer to Quito airport, 30-minute flight transfer, 2-hour motorized boat ride, 40-minute canoe ride

ACTIVITY: 25-minute jungle walk



Explore the Amazon Rainforest

Spend the day exploring the pristine rainforest around the lodge, home to an amazing variety of wildlife. Watch for roving bands of monkeys, hundreds of species of birds, and the occasional anteater, three-toed sloth, or ocelot. Giant otters also make their home in the lake alongside the lodge and can often be spotted playing and fishing. Go for a ride in a dugout canoe, fish for piranhas, and birdwatch from the top of a canopy tower. You can also go on a night walk to look for frogs, spiders, and other nocturnal critters.

Visit an Indigenous Community

Enjoy another full day of activities around your lodge. Rise early and cruise along the river to visit one of the parrot clay licks, with the possibility of spotting five species, including parrots, parakeets, and macaws. Hike into the rainforest to visit a project run by and benefiting the women of a local indigenous community. Learn about how they live, the food they eat, and their culture. In the afternoon, walk trails or canoe canals for encounters with a diverse range of birds and mammal species. In the evening, take an optional night canoe ride to look for caimans, snakes, and other nocturnal wildlife.

Return to Quito

After breakfast, depart your lodge and take a return boat ride to Coca. Then, board your flight back to Quito and transfer to the hotel. The rest of the day is free to relax at the swimming pool or visit the Old Town on your own.

Fly to San Cristobal Island in the Galapagos

After breakfast, fly from Quito to San Cristobal in the Galapagos Islands. On arrival your guide will escort you to Puerto Baquerizo Moreno, where you will board the deluxe EcoGalaxy. Enjoy lunch before cruising to nearby Isla Lobos — separated from San Cristobal by a narrow channel, providing opportunities to snorkel with sea lions, sea turtles, and tropical fish. There is also a short trail great for viewing blue-footed boobies, frigatebirds, sea lions, and the picturesque Leon Dormido — a huge volcanic monolith located offshore.

TRANSPORTATION: 1-hour van transfer to Quito airport, 2-hour flight transfer

ACTIVITY: PM 1.5 hours moderate hike (0.5 miles), plus snorkeling and panga cruise



Visit Santa Fe & South Plaza Islands

Wake to explore the beautiful bay and turquoise waters of Santa Fe Island. After a wet landing on a white beach usually covered with sea lions, walk into a giant Opuntia cactus grove in search of endemic land iguanas and possibly Galapagos Hawks. Afterwards, you can snorkel and/or kayak in the turquoise waters of the bay, full of sea lions, sea turtles, rays, urchins, eels, and very colorful fish, including large schools of surgeonfish and parrotfish. Next it's on to South Plaza Island for an afternoon walk. Both North and South Plazas were formed by geological uplift and tilt to the north, with cliffs on their southern coasts. On small islands like this, terrestrial and marine species interact more than on the larger islands, and the occasional hybrid iguana (land and marine) with its "zebra-like" stripes can often be observed. The south facing cliffs swarm with a myriad of bird species, including tropicbirds, pelicans, boobies, Galapagos shearwaters, and swallow-tailed gulls. Bachelor sea lions climb steep cliffs in the late afternoon to spend nights away from the larger dominant bulls. Look for endemic land iguanas under the prickly-pear cactus.

ACTIVITY: AM 1 hour easy walk (0.5 miles) and option for snorkeling or kayaking; PM 2 hours easy walk (1 mile)

North Seymour Island and Mosquera Islet

North Seymour is home to an incredible diversity of species, including dense breeding colonies of blue-footed boobies and frigatebirds. Walk North Seymour's loop trail and keep an eye out for Swallow tailed gulls, blue-footed boobies, and colonies of both Magnificent and Great frigatebirds. The island is rich in sea birds, but look also for marine iguanas, huge land iguanas, sea lions and other smaller birds such as Darwin finches and mockingbirds. After the walk, get ready to snorkel in one of the sites with the highest diversity of fish you'll find on your trip. This afternoon, make a wet landing at Mosquera Islet, located between Baltra Island and North Seymour, and set out on foot to explore the largest sea lion colony in the archipelago. It's also possible to observe several species of birds here.

Discover Rich Birdlife of Genovesa Island

Genovesa Island is known as Bird Island and is one of the most interesting for visitors! Make a wet landing this morning and hike along Darwin Beach on the north side of Darwin Bay, formed by the rim of a sunken crater. Red mangroves along the trail provide habitat for yellow warblers, yellow-crowned night herons, and pintail ducks. The highlight of this site is the incredible abundance of Red-footed Boobies, Great Frigatebirds and Swallow-tailed Gulls. Despite being the most abundant species of booby in the islands, the red-footed is rarely seen unless you visit Genovesa. The bay also offers several places to snorkel; from deep waters along the cliffs across the bay, to shallow waters by the beach. In either case, there are many fish to see and great chances of seeing sharks, rays and sea lions. After lunch, explore the cliffs by panga before climbing Prince Phillip's Steps to the island's plateau. The landing spot is a rock fall that forms a natural staircase up the cliffs but the rest of the trail is quite easy and level. Walk through massive colonies of Red-footed and Nazca Boobies and an extraordinary Palo Santo forest on the way to a lava ridge where thousands of storm petrels dart about while Short-eared owls stalk them for prey. This is one of the trails with the most abundance of fauna in the entire Galapagos. Snorkelers can explore the cliffs, where there are many fish and great chances of seeing sharks, rays and sea lions. Back on the boat tonight, enjoy a festive farewell cocktail hour and a group dinner with the captain.

ACTIVITY: AM 2 hours easy hike (1 mile) plus snorkeling ; PM 2.5 hours moderate hike (2 miles) plus snorkeling



See Tortoises in the Highlands & Return to Quito

After an early breakfast, disembark the EcoGalaxy and transfer to the lush highlands of Santa Cruz Island for a special opportunity to see Galapagos giant tortoises in the wild. Then head to the Baltra airport for your return flight to Quito. An MT Sobek representative will greet you at Quito airport and provide assistance to your nearby hotel. Lunch and dinner are on your own today.

TRANSPORTATION: 45-minute private vehicle transfer and 2-hour flight transfer

ACTIVITY: AM 1.5 hours easy walk (1 mile)
