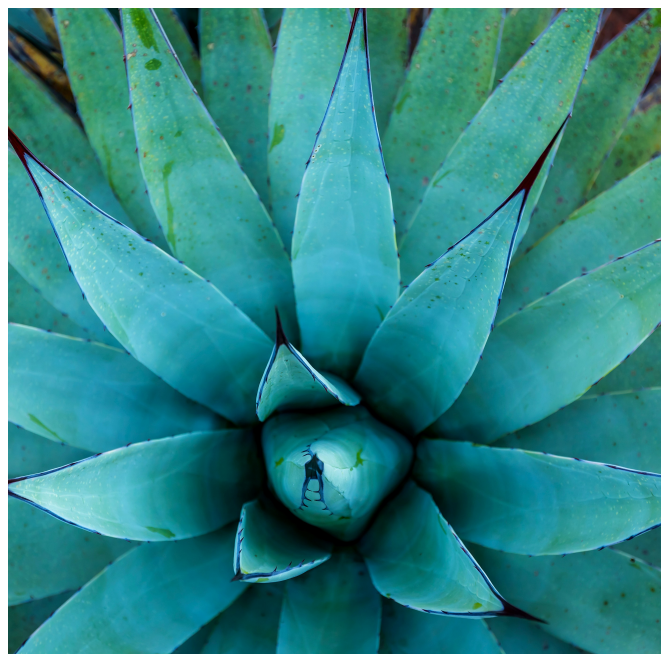

The Itinerary

DAY 01

Drive to the Grand Canyon & Take a Sunset Helicopter Flightseeing Tour

Begin your Arizona adventure with a scenic drive from your arrival point in Phoenix to the South Rim of Grand Canyon National Park. Upon arrival, take to the skies on a breathtaking 45-minute helicopter flight. Fly over the iconic canyon as the sun dips low and lights up the colors of the gorge—enjoying an extraordinary aerial perspective. After your flight, check into your lodge and settle in for the evening as your excitement builds for the next adventure.

Enjoy a Private Guided Hike in Grand Canyon National Park

Sedona is designated as an International Dark Sky Park for its famously dark skies.

Under Canvas Grand Canyon

Under Canvas Grand Canyon offers a true glamping experience on a 160 acre property just 25 miles from Grand Canyon National Park. The camp seamlessly blends into the surrounding pinon and juniper forest. The luxury wall tents feature the comforts of home, including stately beds with luxurious linens. In the evening relax around the campfire with s'mores and take in the twinkling stars.

Thunderbird Lodge

Built near the Bright Angel Trail head and the Vercamps Visitor Center, the Thunderbird is a popular South Rim lodge. Contemporary 1960s architecture coupled with a wonderful vantage point ensure an unforgettable stay on the very edge of a natural wonder of the world. Comfortable rooms have all the expected amenities but the biggest draw is the location.

Amara Resort and Spa

The Amara Resort and Spa is tucked along the banks of Oak Creek Canyon like a secret sanctuary, just steps from Uptown Sedona. The striking infinity pool, hosted evening social hour and outdoor fire pits are the perfect way to unwind after the day's adventures. SaltRock Southwest Kitchen offers an authentic taste of Sedona with seasonal fare and local Verde Valley ingredients.

Enchantment Resort

Located on 70 acres of panoramic red-rock terrain near Sedona, Enchantment Resort is a beautiful retreat. The 5-star amenities and magnificent setting in Boynton Canyon will inspire your spirit, and soothe your body and mind. The resort features unique casita style accommodations that embrace the surroundings and all feature lavish, yet soothing furnishings, authentic Southwestern appointments, plush beds, luxurious linens, spacious bathrooms and private decks that overlook the red rock formations. The full service resort also offers daily activities and children's programs, tennis courts, croquet, bocce ball, an indoor pool, steam room, fitness center, the Seven Canyons Golf Club, Mii amo destination spa, and several on-property dining options including Che Ah Chi which serves modern American cuisine with Native American influences.
