Experience Prague's Baroque and Gothic spires, Kutna Hora's silver mining legacy, and Cesky Krumlov's cobbled medieval streets, as you ramble between picturesque villages, enchanting castles, inviting landscapes, and awe-inspiring views. Cross into Austria where exhilarating ascents by cable car to mountain peaks and serene vistas overlooking tranquil lakes culminate in Salzburg's historic city center, the birthplace of Mozart. Bring home outstanding memories forged amidst these iconic destinations.

### The Itinerary



#### Arrive in Prague & the Stroll the Medieval Old Town

On arrival in the Czech Republic, your MT Sobek guide will meet you at Prague Airport for a transfer to your hotel. This afternoon, wander amidst majestic landmarks including the awe-inspiring Hradcany Castle, the sublime St. Vitus Cathedral, and the iconic Charles Bridge. Explore the enchanting medieval architecture of Prague's historic center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, immersing yourself in its timeless charm. In the evening, come together with your fellow travelers and guide for a delightful welcome dinner, marking the beginning of your unforgettable journey.

TRANSPORTATION: 30-minute private airport transfer



#### **Drive to Hruba Skala & Discover Bohemian Paradise**

Start the day with a scenic drive through picturesque rolling hills, verdant forests, and charming villages as you head towards Bohemian Paradise. See the topography transform into more rugged terrain with dramatic rocky outcrops and spectacular sandstone formations. Continue into Hruba Skala, marked by a striking medieval castle perched atop a rocky cliff. From here, hike a loop trail that winds through dense forest and expansive meadows, encountering some of the area's famed geologic wonders along the way. Take in a breathtaking view of the surrounding countryside before taking the return route to Hruba Skala for a well-earned dinner.

**TRANSPORTATION:** 2-hour private transfer

ACTIVITY: 4-5 hours/7 miles hiking with 1,400' of elevation gain/loss



#### **Explore Bohemian Paradise Trails & Astonishing Architecture**

Following a hearty breakfast, embark on a second hike through the beautiful Bohemian Paradise, traversing forested hills on a scenic journey to Kost Castle, a majestic example of Gothic architecture surrounded by three lakes. Then, visit the Empire-style Kacina Chateau, where you'll have the opportunity to explore its classicist library and admire the elegant grounds. Continue your journey to the jaw-dropping Baroque ossuary at the Cathedral of Our Lady at Sedlec before arriving at Kutna Hora.

TRANSPORTATION: 2-hour private transfer

**ACTIVITY:** 3 hours/5 miles hiking with 680' of elevation gain and 1,060' loss



#### Follow the Way of St. James & Explore Kutna Hora

Today's journey unfolds with a drive to the charming village of Malesov, where you begin an enchanting hike along the Way of St. James, a part of the renowned pilgrimage route, the Camino de Santiago. Your hike takes you back to Kutna Hora, where you will begin to explore this historical gem of a town renowned for its pivotal role as a prominent silver mining center during the Middle Ages. Rising to become a royal city in the 14th century, its opulent buildings symbolize the prosperity fueled by mining. Tour the stunning Gothic architecture of the Cathedral of St. Barbara and follow the cobbled streets of the city's UNESCO-listed historical center on your way to visit the Czech Museum of Silver where you'll gain insights into the profound influence that mining has had, shaping the cultural and economic landscape of Kutna Hora.

**MEALS:** Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

**ACTIVITY:** 4 hours/7 miles hiking with 460' of elevation gain and 820' loss



#### Roam Rural Holasovice Village & Mt. Klet Summit

Today traverse fertile plains, undulating hills, a patchwork of agricultural fields, and storybook villages as you drive towards historic Holasovice, a veritable treasure, protected by UNESCO. Here, you'll amble amidst captivating farmhouses and barns, surrounded by vegetable gardens and bountiful orchards. Continue to Holubov, where you'll board a cable car for an exhilarating ride to the summit of Mt. Klet (3,566'), the highest peak in the Blansky Forest. After soaking in splendid views, begin your descent on foot through spruce and pine forest, passing quaint villages and excellent views along the route. Reaching the cobblestone streets of Cesky Krumlov, check in to your hotel for the next two nights.

TRANSPORTATION: 3-hour private transfer

ACTIVITY: 3-4 hours/6 miles hiking with 130' of elevation gain and 2,000' of elevation loss



#### **Experience Enchanting Cesky Krumlov**

Wake in a town nestled onto the banks of the VItava River and centered around its crown jewel, a majestic 13th-century castle. Explore its ornate interiors including a fairy-tale Baroque theater. Tred the cobbled streets, meticulously laid out according to medieval blueprints, exploring more of its UNESCO-listed highlights. This afternoon, take a short hike to a Baroque-period pilgrimage site on Krizova Hora (Cross Mountain) for spellbinding panoramas of Cesky Krumlov's steeples, towers, and terracotta rooftops against the backdrop of the surrounding landscape. Return to town where the evening beckons with opportunities to savor a delectable dinner at your leisure amidst Cesky Krumlov's historic charms.

**MEALS:** Breakfast | Lunch

**ACTIVITY:** 2-3 hours/4 miles hiking with 750' of elevation gain/loss







#### **Cross into Austria for an Alpine Hike, Lake & Views**

Begin your day by travelling across the border into Austria to the town of Gmunden, which sits at the edge of the shimmering shores of Lake Traunsee and is home to the charming castle of Schloss Ort. After lunch, a cable car will usher you towards the summit of Mt. Grunberg (3,228'). At the top you will discover a 128-foot spiraling walkway soaring above the forest canopy. Ascend and be rewarded with awe-inspiring 360-degree views, offering panoramic vistas of the charming town, the glistening lake, and the majestic landscapes beyond. Then, enjoy a forested ridge trail to the picturesque Lake of Laudachsee mirroring the steep-sided rocks of Mt. Traunstein before descending along a forest path back to Lake Traunsee for a short drive to your hotel.

**TRANSPORTATION:** 2-hour private transfer

ACTIVITY: 5-6 hours/7 miles hiking with 330' of elevation gain and 2,130' of elevation loss



#### Hike to Waterfalls from Hallstatt & Arrive in Salzburg

Rise for a morning transfer to Obertraun cable car station where you'll board for a fun ride with sensational scenery to heights surpassing 6,560 feet. At the top step out onto the Five Fingers viewing platform, the most iconic overlook in the Austrian Alps. From this lofty vantage point, look out over the Dachstein Range and Hallstatt village, sitting on the shores of Hallstattersee Lake. Return by cable car to Obertraun and drive 15 minutes to Hallstatt village where you'll gear up for the last hike of the trip, a lovely loop through Hallstatt to Echerntal valley waterfalls. Conclude your day with a transfer to Salzburg, where a delicious farewell dinner awaits, along with the opportunity to reflect on your incredible adventures.

**TRANSPORTATION:** 1.5-hour private transfer

**ACTIVITY:** 4 hours/7 miles hiking with 990' of elevation gain/loss



#### **Explore Salzburg & Depart**

After breakfast, enjoy a walking tour of the UNESCO-protected historic city center of Salzburg. Immerse yourself in the timeless beauty of this enchanting locale, largely influenced by Italian Baroque architects Vincenzo Scamozzi and Santini Solari. Transfer to the airport for flights home or on to your next destination.

### Where You'll Stay

#### **Hotel Adria**

Centrally located at Wenceslas Square, within easy walking distance of shops and historical sights, Hotel Adria is a family-run hotel in operation since 1912. Sleep in spacious fully renovated rooms with luxury bedding, LED TV, air-conditioning, ensuite bath, and Wi-Fi. Many rooms have views of the Franciscan Garden or the city. The Art Nouveau Triton Restaurant has a gourmet menu and is decorated with a stalactite theme.

#### **EA Chateau Hotel**

Once a castle, after many reconstructions, the Neo-Gothic chateau is now home to the EA Chateau Hotel and retains much of its historical charm. Guests can take in views of the old castle rampart and the striking scenery of Bohemian Paradise. Spacious rooms make the perfect retreat after a day of exploring with LCD TV, Wi-Fi, ensuite bath, and minibar. Enjoy a soothing massage at the spa.

#### **Hotel U Kata**

At the edge of the city's historic center, Hotel U Kata is bordered by the remains of the Executioner's Gate in the old city wall, a short distance from historical monuments. It offers 40 rooms with ensuite bath, satellite TV, and Wi-Fi. The inviting restaurant is styled as a medieval tavern serving Czech cuisine. Treat yourself to a massage or try the beer spa in historical cellars with vaulted ceilings!

#### **Hotel Ruze**

Perched above the VItava River, Hotel Ruze is housed in a 16th century estate with stunning views of the surrounding landscape. Many original archways and frescoes remain, and the 71 rooms are beautifully renovated with a historic feel. Each room is unique, but all include ensuite bath, Wi-Fi, satellite TV and minifridge. A restaurant and bar, spa, and swimming pool complete the experience.

#### **Hotel Schwan**

First opened in 1502, the family-run Hotel Schwann is conveniently located in the town square on the shores of Lake Traunsee. Rooms offer views of the town square or lake, and many have balconies. The restaurant serves traditional dishes created with locally sourced ingredients including fish from the lake, along with a selection of wines from Austria and nearby countries. Dine indoors or on the sunny lakeside terrace.

#### Seegasthof Hois'n Wirt

#### **Hotel Scherer**

Centrally located, yet on a quiet side street, Hotel Scherer has been in operation since 1850 and is an ideal spot for exploring the region. This 4-star hotel offers 50 bright, renovated, guiet rooms with airconditioning, Wi-Fi, and tasteful interiors. The restaurant serves a hearty buffet breakfast in a light-filled room, and the garden is open for some fresh air when the weather allows it.
