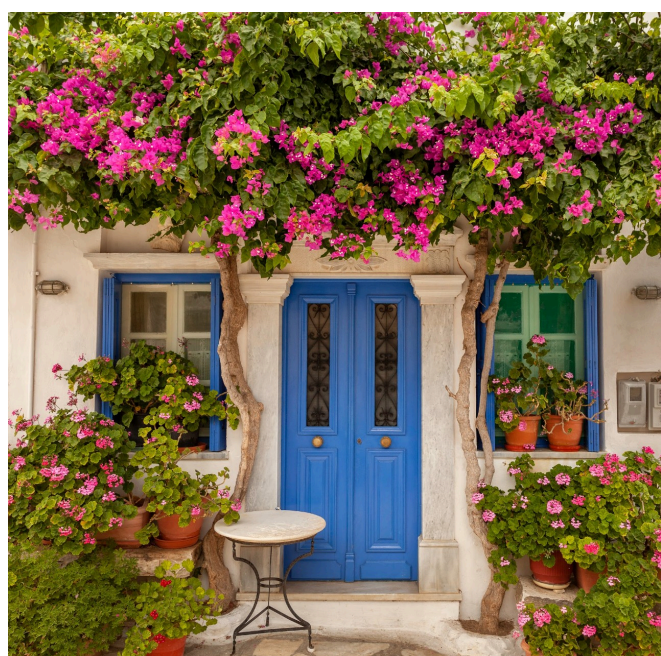
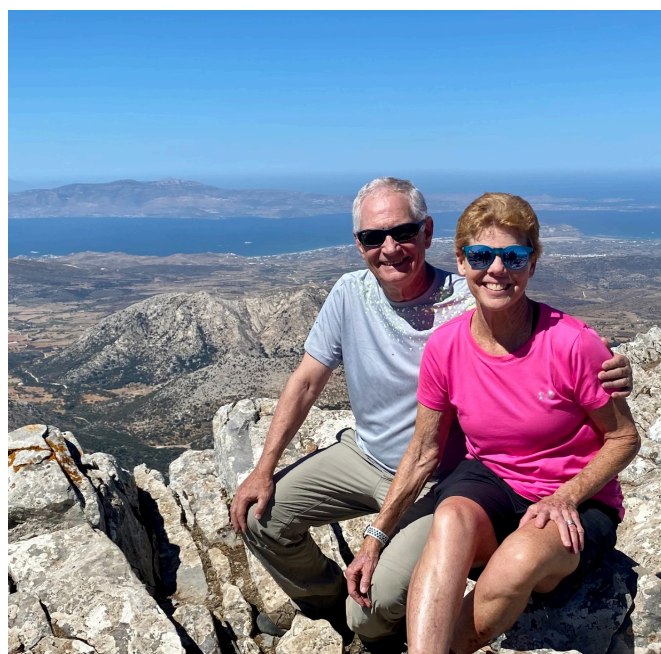

Embark on a Greek odyssey brimming with ancient ruins, idyllic villages, soaring peaks, and sweeping coastal vistas. Tour the ancient Acropolis of Athens, a UNESCO Heritage Site, then head south to the Cyclades, a group of islands known for their whitewashed villages, magnificent beaches, and stunning landscapes. Hike village to village on the island of Tinos, and to the top of Mt. Zas, the birthplace of Zeus, on Naxos. Hike beautiful Santorini's caldera and enjoy a sunset kayak. Savor homemade meals in the shade of grapevines and enjoy comfortable hotels full of local character.

The Itinerary

DAY 01

Arrive in Athens

Welcome to Greece! An MT Sobek representative will meet you and the group at Athens International Airport and transfer you together to your hotel. Meet up this evening for a welcome orientation and a stroll through the historic Plaka neighborhood, famous for its labyrinthine streets and neoclassical architecture, to a local restaurant for your first taste of the flavors of Greece.

MEALS: Dinner

DAY 02

Discover Athens and Travel to Tinos

Explore Athens, once a powerful city-state and today the capital of Greece. Take the millennia-old journey up the hill for a private tour of the Acropolis, the ancient citadel, and admire the Parthenon temple, dedicated to the goddess Athena. Marvel at the archaeological treasures at the New Acropolis Museum, then tour the city on wheels to see the temple of Zeus, the Hellenic Parliament, and the Panathenaic Stadium, which hosted the first Olympic Games. After a lunch in the port of Rafina, hop on a ferry to Tinos, your first stop in the Cyclades.

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 1-hour vehicle transfer; 2-hour catamaran ride

DAY 03

Hike Village to Village on Tinos Island

Today, hike and explore the enchanting island of Tinos. Starting from the village of Volax, which sits nestled in a lunar landscape of large granite boulders, make your way to the tiny hillslope village of Koumaros. Refresh with a traditional Greek coffee that will power your climb to Xobourgo hill with its splendid vistas over the Aegean Sea. Descend to the seaside village of Kionia and relax over a leisurely lunch. Then take a dip next to the remains of the ancient temple of Poseidon, the god of the sea. This evening, enjoy dinner in Tinos.

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 50-minute round-trip transfer

ACTIVITY: 5.5 miles/4 hours hiking with elevation gain of 820' and elevation loss of 1,700'



DAY 04

Discover Kouros Statues on Naxos

Bid farewell to Tinos and take a morning ferry to Naxos island, the largest of the Cyclades. Settle in at the hotel, then head out for a hike to two monumental statues: 20-foot Kouros of Melanes and the 16-foot Kouros of Potamia. Refresh by a spring in Ano Potamia village, then trek to Apano Kastro (Upper Castle) to admire the marvelous panoramas of Naxos. Wrap up the day with an amazing homestyle dinner under the shade of grapevines.

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 2-hour ferry transfer; 1-hour private transfer

ACTIVITY: 4.5 miles/4 hours hiking with elevation gain of 912' and elevation loss of 666'

DAY 05

Conquer Mount Zas, the Birthplace of Zeus

Journey to the small hilltop chapel of Aghia Marina, the starting point of today's hike to the top of Mt. Zas. As well as being the highest peak in the Cyclades at 3,290 feet, Zas is also the legendary birthplace of Zeus! Take in the splendid views of Naxos from the top then descend to the village of Filoti for lunch. Return to Naxos for dinner this evening.

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 40-minute bus transfer and 30-minute taxi ride

ACTIVITY: 5 miles/4.5 hours hiking with elevation gain of 1100' and loss of 2000'



Travel to Santorini & Paddle along Volcanic Cliffs

After breakfast, take a high-speed ferry to stunning Santorini, an island created by a volcanic eruption and one of the most photogenic places in all of Greece. Unwind over lunch in the hotel, then embark on a kayaking tour at sunset, a one-of-a-kind way to see Santorini's cliffs and beaches. Savor a local dinner at a beachside restaurant before returning to the hotel.

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 70-minute ferry ride and 30-minute hotel transfer

ACTIVITY: 2-hour sunset kayaking tour



Take the Ultimate Santorini Hike

Start the day by exploring the Bronze Age village of Akrotiri, one of the most important archaeological sites on the Aegean coast and famed for its well-preserved frescoes. Re-energize over lunch, then begin your hike from Fira to Oia along the rim of the caldera. With vistas of blue domes and whitewashed facades, this hike is a quintessential Santorini experience. Take in the resplendent sunset at Oia, then toast to your journey over a farewell dinner.

MEALS: Breakfast | Dinner

ACTIVITY: 6.5 miles/4.5hours hiking with elevation gain of 1100' and loss of 1800'

After breakfast, fly from Santorini to Athens for connecting afternoon flights.

Royal Olympic Hotel

The five-star Royal Olympic is an elegant hotel in the heart of Athens. Its comfortable rooms are stylishly decorated and come with modern amenities. Guests can enjoy access to the swimming pool, gym, and to the Roof Garden Restaurant & Bar, which offers an ultimate dining experience with a spectacular view of the Acropolis.

Onar Hotel and Suites

Overlooking the old port, Onar Hotel and Suites is the perfect spot to soak up the vibe of Tinos' seaside. Featuring clean lines and Cycladic decor, the 15 well-appointed apartments all open to a balcony or the courtyard patio, with a pool that boasts views of the Aegean Sea. All units are air-conditioned, most have a kitchenette, and some come with a fireplace.

Porto Naxos Hotel

Guestrooms are equipped with free Wi-Fi and flat-screen TVs, as well as minibars, safes, and tea and coffeemaking facilities. All feature private balconies or terraces. There is a wine cellar, and a chic restaurant with a terrace. Other amenities include an outdoor pool and a tennis court, in addition to a gym and a sauna. Spa treatments can be arranged.

Naxos Resort Beach Hotel

Conveniently located a short distance from old town, Chora Castle, and Apollo's Temple, Naxos Resort offers 88 elegant rooms with views of the gardens, pool, or sea. Each features a private balcony or terrace, air-conditioning, complimentary Wi-Fi, and cable TV. Guests can splash in the swimming pool or enjoy the outdoor Jacuzzi. There is also a sauna, fitness center, and massage services.

El Greco Resort and Spa

Near the center of Santorini, El Greco Resort & Spa is the perfect place to unwind. Opportunities for poolside lounging abound; there are five outdoor pools, an indoor one, two open-air Jacuzzis, and an adult-only spa. The traditional whitewashed buildings have more than 200 bedrooms, all showcasing minimalist Santorini-style decor, as well as amenities like A/C, satellite TVs and mini-fridges.

Splendour Resort

Splendour Resort offers Cycladic 5-star accommodations in the picturesque town of Firostefani. Eighty-three rooms feature amenities such as a flat-screen satellite TV, free Wi-Fi, a complimentary set of bathrobes and slippers, and private balconies that face the stunning views of the eastern Aegean Sea. The on-site restaurant serves an a la carte menu and a delicious buffet breakfast, and there is a pool bar in a swimming pool area where guests can sip on refreshing cocktails.

Santorini Palace

The Santorini Palace, a perfect stop on your Santorini Island adventure, is 10 minutes from the capital of Santorini. Enjoy the hotel's spacious rooms, featuring air conditioning, a satellite, flat-screen TV, private bathroom, balcony, and much more. While you are there, dine at the onsite restaurant or head to the onsite gym. Relax and re-energize at the pool.
