The Itinerary



Arrive in Florence & Journey to Tavarnelle

Welcome to Italy! Arrive in Florence this afternoon and meet your trip leader for an orientation. Explore the Benedictine church of San Miniato al Monte, with its splendid Romanesque architecture and sweeping views of the city, before heading south to the hilltop town of Tavarnelle. Enjoy a scenic drive on the Via Cassia, an ancient Roman road, then set off on a hike past olive orchards and vineyards to a 12th-century family estate. Here you'll sample olive oils and savor a delicious country dinner.

Chianti Wines & Walks

Rise for a journey through bucolic rolling hills to Greve, the wine capital of Chianti. Take a picturesque hike to the hilltop village of Lamole. Lunch on local delights and continue on foot to Volpaia, a medieval hamlet famed for its Chianti Classico wine. Here you'll sample some of the region's most celebrated reds. Rest up tonight in your charming hotel in the historic town of Radda.

Vineyard Trails to San Polo in Rosso

Begin the day with a short transfer to San Giusto in Salcio, a pretty Romanesque church just south of Radda in Chianti. From here, you'll follow vineyard trails to the fortified medieval estate of San Polo in Rosso, where lunch awaits. Continue walking via enchanting rural villages back to San Giusto in Salcio. Return by van to Radda and sample more Chianti wines before exploring the town at leisure. Tonight, dinner is on your own at the hotel or local restaurant.

Explore Enchanting Siena

Journey to the captivating city of Siena for a special guided tour of its historical wonders, including UNESCO-listed Piazza del Campo and the Duomo. Next, enjoy free time to explore the city's beautiful cobblestone streets and charming restaurants. In the afternoon, visit the walled city of Monteriggioni, known as the "Gateway to the Middle Ages" for its fortified ramparts and watchtowers. Later, transfer to your hotel set in a 15th-century villa in Poggibonsi.

Hike to San Gimignano

Start the day with a drive to Colle Val d'Elsa, known for its fine Italian crystal, then follow scenic trails to the romantic hill town of San Gimignano. This UNESCO World Heritage wonder, known as "medieval Manhattan," is beloved for its 11th-century towers, labyrinthine streets, and fresco-adorned Duomo. Explore town before heading back to your hotel.

Journey from Carrara to Cinque Terre

Rise for a drive to Carrara, world famous for its ancient marble quarries that rise like snow-capped peaks above the town. After lunch, breathtaking coastal scenery awaits in the UNESCO-listed Cinque Terre and the pretty seaside town of Levanto. Enjoy a tasty dinner in town and get ready to explore the Italian Riviera over the next two days.

ACCOMMODATION: Hotel La Giada del Mesco, Levanto MEALS: Breakfast |Lunch | Dinner TRANSPORTATION: 2.75-hour private van transfer



Explore Trails in Cinque Terre

Take a short train ride to Monterosso al Mare, one of the five towns that make up the Cinque Terre. Perched on cliffs above the Ligurian Sea, these breathtakingly beautiful seaside villages are a bucketlist must — and perfect for hikers. Take in amazing coastal scenery on a stunning trail that links the neighboring villages of Vernazza, Corniglia, Manarola, and Riomaggiore. Alternatively, you can enjoy a scenic train and boat ride from village to village. Return to Levanto for dinner on your own tonight.

Coastal Path to Monterosso

Starting at the hotel, follow a meandering coastal trail back to Monterosso. Along the way you'll pass lemon groves and old hilltop farmhouses, and enjoy splendid views of the Ligurian Sea. Perhaps reward yourself with a refreshing gelato and explore the town at leisure. Take a train back to Levanto and celebrate your Italian adventure with a farewell dinner in town.

Depart from Pisa

Bid farewell to Italy as you transfer to the airport in Pisa.

The Hotel Executive

Occupying a former royal residence built in the 16th century, this elegant hotel is just a 7-minute walk from Santa Maria Novella train station and 9 minutes on foot from the Santa Maria Novella. The traditionally furnished, warmly decorated rooms feature flat-screen TVs, free Wi-Fi and minibars. There's a restaurant, a cocktail lounge and a library reading room.

Hotel Palazzo Leopoldo

This elegant hotel is set in a 14th-century Tuscan building, and is nestled in Chianti's vineyards. Guestrooms offer old-world charm and feature free Wi-Fi, room service and flat-screen TVs. Amenities include a restaurant and a fitness room, as well as a spa with a heated indoor pool and hot tubs.

Palazzo San Niccolo

The romance of a 15th century palace with original frescoes and architectural details takes you back through history as you step out onto the main square. Modern rooms continue the theme with Tuscan terracotta flooring, beamed ceilings, and marble showers. In the historic vaulted cellar, a heated indoor swimming pool, whirlpool, massage services, and sauna. Enjoy the sights of Radda in Chianti from this regal hotel.

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Hotel Villa San Lucchese

Set on beautifully landscaped grounds, this elegant hotel offers down-to-earth guestrooms with free Wi-Fi, satellite TV and safes. Some have canopy beds, whirlpool tubs, exposed beams and/or sitting areas. Other amenities include 2 outdoor pools, a tennis court and a restaurant with a terrace. There's also a landscaped garden, a library and a bar, plus a wine cellar. Wine tastings and massage services are available.

Villa Sabolini

Located in the Tuscan hills outside Siena and near Colle di Val D'Elsa, Villa Sabolini was once an elegant 15th-century residence and later became an Archiepiscopal Seminary. Today the Villa is a 4-star hotel whose 40 rooms are surrounded by an Italian garden, and finely furnished with canopy beds, cotto floors, and marble bathrooms. The restaurant serves traditional dishes made with local ingredients inspired by the seasons.

Hotel La Giada del Mesco

In a stone villa on a hillside overlooking the Ligurian Sea, this relaxed hotel has 12 cozy guestrooms offering minifridges, flat-screen TVs and free Wi-Fi, as well as balconies with sea views. Room service is available. Other amenities include a bar, a terrace, and an infinity pool, all with panoramic sea views.
