Alps Tour de Monte Rosa Trekking

Circle Europe's Second-Highest Peak

Monte Rosa, its rounded crest enveloped in snow and ice is the second-highest peak in the Alps at 15,203 feet. Led by our expert hiking guides, you will conquer majestic alpine peaks and passes. Starting in the village of Saas-Fee and finishing in Zermatt, at the foot of the Matterhorn, hike almost the complete circuit of the massif. Beneath cascading glaciers, through ancient hamlets and wildflower fields, take in vistas of Monte Rosa, and learn about Walser culture and tradition. Travel through the Swiss canton of Valais to Italian Piedmont and Valle d'Aosta, soaking up heartfelt hospitality.

The Itinerary

DAY 01

Arrive in Geneva & Head to Saas-Almagell

Welcome to Switzerland! Arrive at Geneva International Airport, where you will be met by your MT Sobek guide for a transfer to the resort town of Saas-Almagell near Saas-Fee. Sitting at 6,004 feet, this pretty alpine town marvels at the magnificent amphitheater of peaks like Dom, Allalinhorn, Alpubel, and their glaciers. In late afternoon, gather with the group for an orientation followed by dinner.

ACCOMMODATION: Hotel Kristall Saphir, Saas-Almagell

MEALS: Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 3-hour private van transfer

DAY 02

Warm-Up Hikes Around Saas-Fee

Spend the day hiking the trails around Saas-Fee to help you to acclimatize to the altitude. Depending on the weather, enjoy a tram ride to take in the views of Passo del Moro (which you will conquer the next day) or hike the lower trail around Saas Valley and spot wildlife like deer and chamois. The trip participants who wish to take it easy for the day can unwind at the hotel or explore the enchanting Walser culture and architecture on their own.

ACCOMMODATION: Hotel Kristall Saphir, Saas-Almagell

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch

ACTIVITY: 3-5 miles/ 5-7 hours optional hiking (hikes vary on this day)

DAY 03

Soar to Monte Moro Pass & Discover Walser Culture

Along the shores of Stausee Mattmark Lake, walk to the Walser Trail that ascends over rocky outcrops to the highest point of the day, Monte Moro Pass, at 9,500 feet. Step into the Italian Piedmont and gape at the 16-foot golden statue of Mary of the Snow, and Monte Rosa's imposing 6,000-foot rock wall at the head of Valle Anzasca. After a light lunch at 9,173 feet, descend by tram to Staffa/Macugnaga and visit the Walser museum, dedicated to a culture known for its unique language and ingenious architecture.

ACCOMMODATION: Hotel Zumstein, Macugnaga

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

ACTIVITY: 5 miles/4.5 hours hiking with a maximum elevation gain of 2,294'



DAY 04

Hike the Scenic Passo del Turlo

After transferring to the trailhead in the town of Borca, hike up well-maintained mule paths to the Passo del Turlo at 8,981 feet. Along the way, pass the Fairies Lake, brooks and waterfalls like La Pissa, and keep an eye out for ibexes and marmots. Weather permitting, savor a picnic at the pass. Descend 5,000 feet into the village of Alagna Valsesia, taking in the views of the soaring summits of Corno Nero (14,392'), Punta Parrot (14,772'), and Punta Gnifetti (15,165') along the way.

ACCOMMODATION: Hotel Monterosa, Alagna Valsesia

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

ACTIVITY: 15 miles/8.5-9 hours hiking with an elevation gain of 5,001' and loss of 5,078'

DAY 05

Tackle Colle d'Olen, the Highest Pass of the Trek

Hike through gorgeous wildflower fields and a string of charming hamlets — Follu, Scarpia, and Pianmisura. Skirt the Sasso del' Diavolo rock ('Devil's Stone'), then tackle a steep trail to Colle d'Olen pass, at 9,594 feet. The highest point of the tour showcases astounding views of ibexes grazing below the pass. After lunch, follow along a dirt road down to the delightful village of Gressoney-La-Trinité, where, if time permits, you can visit the Walser Cultural Center. Bid farewell to Piedmont and say hello to Valle D'Aosta.

ACCOMMODATION: Romantik Hotel Jolanda Sport, Gressoney La Trinité

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

ACTIVITY: 12 miles/9 hours hiking an elevation gain of 5,822' and loss of 4,265'



Marvel at Mont Blanc from Colle del Pinter Pass

From the postcard-pretty Gressoney Valley over wildflower pastures dotted with farmhouses, venture to the Colle del Pinter pass at 9,247 feet. Savor a picnic on a backdrop of three glorious peaks: the Mont Blanc, the Grand Combin, and the Dent d'Hèren. As you descend into the Walser hamlet of Cuneaz, marvel at the Italian side of the Matterhorn, the Breithorn, and Monte Rosa massif. Relax overnight in the quaint Champoluc, a village where the Walser people have blended in harmoniously with the local culture.

ACCOMMODATION: Hotel Castor, Champoluc

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

ACTIVITY: 12 miles/8 hours hiking with elevation gain of 4,585' and loss of 3,680'



Ascend to Col de Nana & See Cervino, the Italian Matterhorn

Transfer to the Alpe di Nana Alta trailhead and start hiking over dirt roads and alpine trails to the Col de Nana pass at 9,241 feet. Descend along the Colle di Croux route — an adventure filled with resplendent views of Cervino, the Italian side of the Matterhorn, and the stunning series of peaks beside it. Refresh with a beverage in the hamlet of Cheneil, then embark on the final but steep and forested descent to Valtournenche, one of the most popular resorts in the Val d'Aosta region.

ACCOMMODATION: Hotel Tourist, Valtournenche

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

ACTIVITY: 11.5 miles/6.5 hours hiking with an elevation gain of 1,935' and loss of 4,243'



Savor Fantastic Vistas of Monte Rosa & Stay in Zermatt

Transfer to the popular ski resort of Breuil-Cervinia on the Italian side of the Matterhorn, and hop on a gondola up to the 11,588-foot Plateau Rosa panoramic point in the midst of the Monte Rosa glaciated peaks. Prepare for the grand finale, and cross the untouched Theodul Glacier to Trockner Stegg peak. Descend to Furi and take the tram into Zermatt. Spend the rest of the day exploring the idyllic car-free town of Zermatt at the foot of the Matterhorn.

ACCOMMODATION: Hotel Butterfly, Zermatt

MEALS: Breakfast | Dinner

ACTIVITY: 2.5 miles/1.5 hours glacier crossing and 2 miles/1.5 hours hiking with an elevation loss of 5,381'



Depart from Geneva

After a transfer to Geneva International Airport, say goodbye to your trip leader and fellow travelers. Flights departing on this day should be scheduled after 1pm.

MEALS: Breakfast

TRANSPORTATION: 3-hour private van transfer

Hotel Kristall Saphir Superior

The Hotel Kristall-Saphir is located in front of the village of Saas-Almagell. Renovated in 2021, this elegant hotel provides 53 rooms with awe-inspiring alpine views. The hotel's sauna and steam bath are a great place to warm up after a long day of hiking, and its new dining hall, Restaurant 1659, will enchant you with culinary experiences.

Hotel Zumstein

Built in the 1940s, Zumstein Hotel is a historic getaway at the foot of Monte Rosa. Surrounded by awe-inspiring scenery, its 40 rooms with a clean-lined, simple look all feature balconies. The hotel's sauna is a great place to warm up after a long day of hiking, and its garden is a lovely spot to soak up the grand surrounds of this classic mountain hotel.

Hotel Monterosa

Dating back to 1865, the historic Hotel Monterosa has seen the 19th-century Queen of Italy Margherita of Savoy come through its doors. Today, the renovated hotel offers ten comfortable rooms and three apartments for four to six people. The premises comprise a spacious lounge, sauna, a heated ski room, and a restaurant and bar that serve typical Piedmont dishes and wine.

Romantik Hotel Jolanda Sport

With its genuine alpine vibe, Hotel Jolanda's rooms feature wooden interiors accentuated by refined fabrics and rugs. Spa and wellness experiences abound, from the swimming pool with Jacuzzi to several saunas and a variety of aromatic baths. At the rustic restaurant, guests can enjoy Gressoney's culinary traditions, paired with a wine list of over 100 Italian and French labels.

Hotel Castor

This family-run hotel in the historic heart of Val d'Ayas' Champoluc sits minutes away from the ski lifts. Its mountain-style, timber-paneled rooms feature fantastic views of the scenic surrounds, as do the garden and terrace. Savor the region's wines on a wine tasting and enjoy discounted access to Monterosa Spa with three swimming pools, three saunas, a Turkish bath, and a menu of massages.

Hotel Tourist

Run with warm hospitality by the experienced Herin family, Hotel Tourist has a charming, local vibe. Its 34 modern rooms come with en-suite bathrooms; most also have balconies. At the restaurant, guests can feast on Italian cuisine with an Aosta Valley twist. The hotel's serene garden is the perfect spot to soak up the mesmerizing beauty of the Alps.

Hotel Butterfly

A part of the Best Western Signature Collection, Hotel Butterfly occupies a quiet location in the center of Zermatt. Alpine-style rooms have en-suite bathrooms, and all come equipped with flat-screen TVs. Guests can unwind at the wellness area with a Finnish sauna, an infra-red cabin and a steam room, and enjoy the on-site restaurant and cocktail bar.
