The Itinerary

DAY 01

Arrive in Ushuaia

Arrive in Ushuaia, Argentina, a small but bustling town dramatically located at the base of snowcapped mountains. In the early evening, gather with the group for a briefing on the adventure ahead, followed by a welcome dinner.

ACCOMMODATION: Los Cauquenes Resort & Spa, Ushuaia

MEALS: Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 20-minute private van transfer

DAY 02

Hike Trails in Tierra del Fuego & Set Sail from Ushuaia

After breakfast, set out for nearby Tierra del Fuego National Park for a scenic half-day hike. The park is known for its rich plant species and abundant birdlife, including cormorants, grebes, steamer ducks, and kelp geese. You might even spot one of the less-common Andean condors or black-browed albatross. In the late afternoon, transfer to the port to board your boat, the 210-passenger *Ventus Australis* or *Stella Australis*. After enjoying a welcome cocktail, begin the cruise portion of your trip as you traverse the Beagle Channel and cross from Argentina into Chilean territorial waters. The lights of Ushuaia disappear as you turn into the narrow Murray Channel between Navarino and Hoste islands.

ACCOMMODATION: Aboard *Ventus Australis* or *Stella Australis*

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 1.5-hour private van transfer

ACTIVITY: 4 hours/5 miles hiking with 100' elevation gain & loss

DAY 03

Cape Horn & Wulaia Bay

Cruise across Nassau Bay into the remote archipelago that includes Cape Horn National Park. Go ashore (conditions permitting) on the windswept island that harbors Cape Horn, a rocky promontory overlooking the Drake Passage and once the only navigation route between the Pacific and the Atlantic Oceans. Sail back across to the fabled Wulaia Bay, an area renowned for its mesmerizing beauty and dramatic geography. Visit a museum in the old radio station, and stroll through an enchanted Magellan forest to reach a panoramic viewpoint overlooking the bay.

ACCOMMODATION: Aboard *Ventus Australis* or *Stella Australis*

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

ACTIVITY: Cruising with AM and PM short hikes (1 hour/0.75 miles with 160 steps; 1.5 hours/1-3 miles options)



DAY 04

Pia Glacier & Porter Glacier

Sail to the Avenue of the Glaciers in Alberto de Agostini National Park. Enter a narrow fjord then board a Zodiac for Pia Glacier. Take a short hike for a panoramic view, or a longer, much more difficult walk up a lateral moraine. Later, board Zodiac boats and cruise between high rocky walls until you reach Porter Glacier. Stop to observe its colors, listen to its sounds and if you are lucky, even witness some calving. Stay here for a moment to discuss this incredible ice mass and take some photographs before returning to the ship.

ACCOMMODATION: Aboard Ventus Australis or Stella Australis

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

ACTIVITY: AM 1-1.5 hours/0.3-0.75 miles easy or challenging hiking; PM Zodiac cruise

DAY 05

Agostini Sound to Aguila Glacier & Condor Glacier

Early in the morning, sail through the Cockburn Channel and enter Agostini Sound, taking in the glaciers that descend from the middle of the Darwin Mountain Range. Disembark and go for an easy walk around a lagoon to a prime viewing area right in front of the glacier and take in the stunning views. In the afternoon, approach the Condor Glacier via Zodiac and look for some of the abundant Andean Condors in the area.

ACCOMMODATION: Aboard Ventus Australis or Stella Australis

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

ACTIVITY: AM 1-1.5 hours/0.3-0.75 miles easy or challenging hiking; PM Zodiac cruise



Marvel at the Penguins of Magdalena Island & Transfer to Puerto Natales

After an overnight cruise, go ashore at Magdalena Island at the break of dawn (weather permitting) and see an immense colony of Magellanic penguins that makes their home there. Hike a path that leads through thousands of penguins to a small museum lodged inside a vintage 1902 lighthouse. After a short sail south, disembark late morning at Punta Arenas, Chile. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, then travel across the Patagonian plains to the quiet fishing town of Puerto Natales on the shores of Seno Ultima Esperanza (Last Hope Sound).

ACCOMMODATION: Hotel Costaustralis (Nov 2025) or Remota Patagonia Lodge (Jan to Mar 2026), Puerto Natales

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 3-3.5 hour private van transfer

ACTIVITY: 1 hour/1.25 miles walking on Magdalena Island



Scenic Drive to Torres del Paine National Park

After breakfast, set out on a scenic drive to Torres del Paine National Park, glimpsing your first spectacular views of the Paine Massif (weather permitting). En route, stop for a short visit to the Mylodon Cave, where the remains of a giant ground sloth were found in 1896. Late this afternoon, settle in to rooms at your lodge and observe the ever-changing massif from this exclusive vantage point. Over the next few days, enjoy half-day hikes with views of the ice-clad peaks and granite needles of the Torres del Paine (10,000') and see 3,000 feet of near-vertical granite rising from rolling grasslands and beautiful lakes. National Geographic named Torres del Paine one of the most beautiful places in the world, and you'll enjoy some of the best scenery in the park. Itinerary sequence in Torres del Paine may vary depending on the accommodation locations for your departure - the same hikes will be included but may be in a different sequence.

ACCOMMODATION: Estancia Cerro Guido (November 2025 and February 2026 departures), Hotel Lago Grey (January 2026 departure) or Hotel Rio Serrano (March 2026 departure)

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 3-hour private van transfer

ACTIVITY: 1 hour/1.25 miles walking during cave visit



First Hikes in Torres del Paine National Park

Your Torres del Paine hiking adventure begins with a morning hike along the limit of the park. Enjoy panoramic views of the Paine Massif while looking for local fauna: guanacos, rheas, condors, or maybe even a puma. Towards the end of the hike, stop to appreciate some original cave paintings, and weather permitting, catch glimpses of the famous towers. Return to your private van, and transfer to the northern sector for a stroll along the shores of Laguna Azul. This is one of the park's most beautiful hikes, through open grass fields and up a gentle incline for a picture-perfect view over the lagoon, with the iconic three towers rising majestically above the steppe.

ACCOMMODATION: Estancia Cerro Guido (November 2025 and February 2026 departures), Hotel Lago Grey (January 2026 departure) or Hotel Rio Serrano (March 2026 departure)

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 1-hour private van transfer

ACTIVITY: 3 hours/4 miles hiking with 200' elevation gain & loss, plus 1-2 hour lakeshore walk



Explore Majestic Torres del Paine

Combine a scenic drive to the west side of the park with two short but memorable hikes - one to see the Salto Grande waterfall, beautifully located in front of the Horns (Los Cuernos) of Paine; and the other to view cave paintings drawn by the region's original inhabitants, along the way looking out for llama-like guanacos.

ACCOMMODATION: Rio Serrano (November 2025, January and February 2026 departures) or Estancia Cerro Guido (March 2026 departure)

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 1.5-hour private van transfer

ACTIVITY: 5 hours/7 miles hiking with 200' elevation gain & loss



Get a Close-up View of the Grey Glacier & Hike along the Pingo River

Explore the western side of the park today. Take a boat to get up close to the impressive Grey Glacier with its fantastic blue ice-spires in all kinds of different shapes, then keep an eye out for the rare Andean Deer as you hike along the Pingo River.

ACCOMMODATION: Rio Serrano (November 2025, January and February 2026 departures) or Estancia Cerro Guido (March 2026 departure)

MEALS: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 1-hour private van transfer, 2 hours 45 minute catamaran cruise

ACTIVITY: 3 hours/5 miles hiking with 300' elevation gain & loss



Depart from Puerto Natales

After breakfast, return to Puerto Natales by private van to meet with your afternoon flight to Santiago and continue to your next destination.

MEALS: Breakfast

TRANSPORTATION: 3-hour private van transfer

Los Cauquenes Resort and Spa

Los Cauquenes is Ushuaia's only high-end resort & spa located on the Beagle Channel beach, with wide windows and a stunning communal glass room affording spectacular views of this picturesque waterway. It's also conveniently located just a 15-20 minute drive from the town center and airport. The 45 guestrooms feature luxury amenities and memorable views of the channel and the snowy peaks of the Andes. Relax in the spa, dine at the hotel's prestigious gourmet restaurant, and enjoy direct access to a private beach for shore walks at dawn and dusk, taking in the extraordinary variety of birdlife.

M/V Stella Australis

The *Stella Australis* is a 210-passenger expedition vessel, tailor-made for exploring the remote southern tip of South America. M/V Ventus Australis

The *Ventus Australis* is a new 210-passenger expedition vessel, tailor-made for exploring the remote southern tip of South America. Like her sister ship, *Stella Australis*, she features gourmet dining with an all-inclusive bar, three lounges, an open top deck, and spacious light-filled cabins.

Hotel Costaustralis

This lovely hotel is located in the heart of Puerto Natales, with big windows looking out onto the Last Hope Sound and Patagonian mountains, and just steps away from the restaurants and shops of this charming small town. There are 110 rooms, all spacious and modern, with either sea or city views. In-room amenities include complimentary Wi-Fi, cable TV, individually controlled heating, and en-suite bathrooms. The hotel prides itself on providing everything you need for a restful night and its staff are welcoming and helpful.

Remota Patagonia Lodge

Remota Patagonia Lodge is located on the Last Hope Sound, just a short walk from the charming town of Puerto Natales in southern Chile. Designed by award-winning architect German del Sol, the innovative structure was inspired by the old Patagonian shearing sheds tilted by the wind and prioritizes spectacular views throughout. The comfortable, modern guest rooms all feature views of the mountains, the sound, and the glaciers and are decorated with local wood accents and the finest Peruvian textiles. The hotel also features a heated pool, sauna, souvenir shop, bar, and an onsite restaurant featuring local seafood, exotic meats, local organic vegetables, and Chilean wines.

Hotel Lago Grey

Hotel Lago Grey is the perfect base for discovering the western side of Torres del Paine National Park, and features a privileged view of Grey Lake. The hotel has 60 spacious rooms, including 36 Superior rooms that have lake, mountain, and glacier views. All rooms are warm and comfortable, with Wi-Fi (in common areas), safe, and a phone.

Estancia Cerro Guido

A working ranch in a beautiful setting, Estancia Cerro Guido has comfortable rooms in a ranch-style house, featuring tasteful decor and private bathrooms with bathtubs. Daily breakfast is included, and free Wi-Fi is available in public areas. Explore the garden and grounds, relax in front of the fireplace in the library, and enjoy authentic local delicacies at Kaw restaurant.

Rio Serrano Hotel

The Rio Serrano Hotel + Spa is located in the heart of Patagonia on the banks of the Serrano River, just on the edge of Torres del Paine National Park. From its elegant lobby to its 95 well-appointed rooms, the hotel exudes comfort and charm — and is a perfect choice for adventurers seeking pure relaxation. The hotel's spa includes a pool, sauna, gym and massage room, and has magnificent views of the Paine Massif.
