Come evening, bask in the comfort of luxury ecolodges, perfectly placed for wildlife exploration.

The Itinerary



Arrive in Kigali, Rwanda

Welcome to Rwanda! Arrive in Kigali, the capital of Rwanda, and meet a MT Sobek representative outside the customs and immigration area at the airport, for your transfer to the hotel. This evening, gather for a welcome dinner at the hotel.

MEALS: Dinner

TRANSPORTATION: 15-minute airport shuttle



Head to Akagera National Park

After breakfast, journey to beautiful Akagera National Park in northeast Rwanda. Marvel at an immense variety of wildlife, including the Big Five (lion, leopard, rhino, elephant, and African buffalo) and over 500 different species of birds, on an epic afternoon game drive. See elephants and buffalos emerge from the woodland to drink at the lakes, while giraffes, zebras, and antelopes graze tranquilly on the savannah. Keep an eagle-eye out for a leopard, spotted hyena, or even a lion! Later, settle into your luxury tented ecolodge.

TRANSPORTATION: 3-hour private van transfer



Spot the Big Five in Akagera National Park

Rise for a private boat cruise on the Akagera River in search of water-loving animals like hippos and crocodiles. Next, head out for a game drive followed by a delicious lunch and a rest back at camp. Take another late afternoon game drive on the savannah grassland, keeping watch for lions, rhinos, leopards, buffalos, elephants, antelopes and many more creatures. Share stories of the day's adventures back at camp.

Visit Local Communities

This morning you'll explore nearby communities with local guides who are the key to authentic cultural experiences for park visitors. You'll have a chance to engage with locals and share in part of their daily life, customs, and traditions. This visit directly benefits communities living along the boundary of the park, showing the benefits of tourism, and creating long-term support for the conservation of Akagera National Park. After lunch head out for another game drive and enjoy your final night at Ruzizi Tented Camp.



Explore Kigali & Head to Volcanoes National Park

This morning head out for a guided tour of Kigali and visit the moving Kigali Genocide Memorial, the final resting place for more than 250,000 victims of the genocide against the Tutsi. After lunch at Hotel Des Mille Collines (known for its role in the film Hotel Rwanda), take a drive to Kinigi town at the foot of Virunga Mountains, passing lush hills and mist-shrouded valleys. At the lodge, enjoy an evening presentation by Gorilla Doctors, an organization dedicated to saving the lives of critically endangered mountain gorillas by providing hands-on care in the wild.

TRANSPORTATION: 5-hour private vehicle transfer

ACTIVITY: Guided city tour



Trek the Forest in Search of Gorillas

After breakfast, take a short drive to the park headquarters and meet with local trackers for a talk on the etiquette of gorilla tracking, then hike with a guide through misty rainforest to encounter these gentle giants. Trekking can take anywhere from 1 to 6 hours, on rough and at times muddy terrain; a reasonable degree of fitness is required. The experience of seeing your first mountain gorilla at close range in the wild is among the most extraordinary nature can provide. Trek back to the lodge for a hot lunch. In the afternoon, if time permits visit the Dian Fossey Center and the vibrant markets of Musanze.

ACTIVITY: 1-4 hours gorilla trekking up to 8,833' elevation



Encounter Mountain Gorillas

Rise early for another full day of gorilla tracking. Hike through the bush, pushing your way through the undergrowth and parting thick creepers. Expect to stay with these gentle giants of the African forest for an hour after first encountering them. Volcanoes National Park is renowned for its mountain gorilla population, living in 10 families. Looking deep into their expressive brown eyes is an unparalleled experience. In the afternoon, choose an optional visit to Iby'lwachu Cultural Village or the twin lakes of Burera and Ruhondo. Gather for a festive farewell dinner this evening.

Track Rare Golden Monkeys

This morning set out to explore more of Volcanoes National Park, this time in search of the rare golden monkeys. The park's beautiful bamboo forests are among the only places in Africa to see these charming endangered primates in their natural habitat. After lunch drive back to Kigali and transfer directly to the airport for your flight home.

Kigali Serena Hotel
