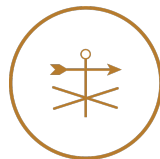

The Itinerary

DAY
01

Arrive in Jackson Hole

Upon arrival at the Jackson airport, collect your rental car and drive to your accommodation, where you will settle in for an evening dedicated to ease, with an unhurried dinner at the hotel where you can soak in the first views of the Wyoming wilderness.

DAY
02

Take a Sunrise Wildlife Safari & Afternoon Private Trail Ride

Wake at dawn for a private wildlife safari in Grand Teton National Park, the best time to spot active elk, moose, and bears against a glowing mountain backdrop. After a midday break to explore the boutiques and cowboy aesthetic of downtown Jackson, head to a nearby ranch for a quintessential two-hour private horseback ride. The trail offers sweeping views of the Snake River Canyon before concluding with a traditional Western-style steak dinner at the ranch.

03

Bike at Grand Teton & Experience Rodeo Rituals

Experience the Teton peaks on two wheels with a 10-mile guided bike tour along a paved pathway through sagebrush plains and pine forests. This evening, dive into Western culture with an exclusive "Behind the Chutes" experience at the Jackson Hole Rodeo. Meet the athletes and animals before settling into the stands for an electrifying showcase of grit and skill that defines this iconic sport.

Hike Jackson Hole & Float Down the Snake River

Meet your private hiking guide to explore the quieter corners of the valley on foot, with a route tailored to your pace. Learn about the ecology of the Greater Yellowstone ecosystem while enjoying a scenic picnic lunch in the mountain stillness. Late this afternoon, board a classic wooden dory for a serene float on the Snake River, culminating in a gourmet dinner served in a beautifully appointed riverside tipi camp.

Kayak in Yellowstone & Journey to Big Sky

Travel north to the shores of Yellowstone National Park for a guided paddle across Yellowstone Lake. After a secluded beach picnic, continue your journey to the high-alpine luxury of Moonlight Basin in Big Sky, Montana, arriving in time for a refined mountain dinner.

Go Whitewater Rafting on the Gallatin River

Gear up for an exhilarating day on the Gallatin River, navigating Class II and III rapids through dramatic rock formations and canyon walls. Between the splash-filled excitement, keep a lookout for wildlife along the rugged banks of this scenic Montana waterway. This active river adventure provides a perfect blend of adrenaline and natural beauty, followed by a relaxing evening at your mountain resort.

Explore Yellowstone National Park & Grizzly Center

Start the day at the Grizzly & Wolf Discovery Center for a close-up look at rescued bears and wolves. Then, enter Yellowstone National Park for a full-day private tour of the "Serengeti of North America". Explore the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone and Hayden Valley, incorporating short hiking stretches to view thundering waterfalls and roaming herds of bison away from the primary crowds.

Enjoy Fly Fishing & a Backcountry Yurt Dinner

Perfect the art of the cast with a half-day fly fishing adventure on the Gallatin River, targeting native rainbow and cutthroat trout. The day concludes with a unique dining experience: travel by vintage army truck to a hidden mountainside yurt for a three-course Montana feast accompanied by live music and sweeping views.

The day concludes with refined Western cuisine and a relaxed evening in the saloon, complete with music, storytelling, and handcrafted cocktails.
